Bath, July 11. — Charles W. "Bob" Messenger, 67, sheriff of Sagadahoc County for 15 years prior to his resignation 12 days ago, died Tuesday at his home. A one time major league baseball player, Messenger later coached football and baseball for two years at Edward Little High School, Auburn.

He was born in Bangor, son of Frank and Cinderella Anthony Messenger. After graduating from Gardiner High School, he entered Bates College but left to play baseball with Toronto in the International League and then with St. Louis and Chicago in the American League.

A resident of Richmond for 16 years prior to his election as sheriff in 1936, Messenger served that town as treasurer and tax collector for several years.

His law enforcement career began in 1924 when he was appointed a deputy sheriff by J. Horace McClure, Bath. Popular throughout the county, he had only to go through the motions of campaigning to win re-election term after term. A Sagadahoc County byword was that, "No man can beat

Bob Messenger." A few tried it, none succeeded.

Messenger was a member of the Masonic Blue Lodge at Gardiner, Enterprise Grange, Richmond, and in Bath, where he had lived since 1938, was a member of Winter Street Congregational Church.

The popular Sagadahoc County official submitted his resignation June 28 to Gov. Frederick G. Payne because of failing health. It was reluctantly accepted by Payne who named Messenger's long time chief deputy, Loring D. Small, 60, of West Bath, as his successor.

Messenger is survived by his widow, Mrs. Rachel Cunningham Messenger, Bath; a brother, Harry Messenger, Randolph; and four sisters, Mrs. Jesse Richardson, Waterville, Mrs. Stewart McCoubry and Miss Elta Messenger, Gardiner, and Mrs. Joseph Marks, Somerville, Mass.

The funeral will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday at the Curtis Funeral Home. Burial will be at Richmond.
