He was born here, son of Fred C. and Gertrude I. Parker Metcalf. He was a graduate of Farmington High School, class of 1918.

He married Esther Savage, June 21, 1924, in Farmington.

Mr. Metcalf worked at Metcalf Wood Product Co. with his brother and father until 1952, at which time he became sole owner and operator, retiring in 1967.

He was a member of the Old South Congregational Church of Farmington, having served as the senior

deacon at one time. From 1954 until 1974, he was director of the Northeast Bank of Farmington.

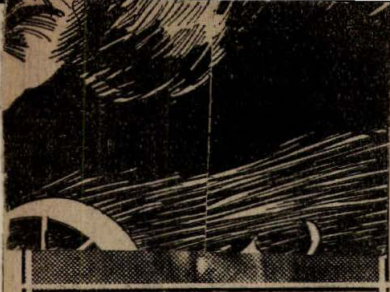

FARMINGTON, Dec. 24 (Special.)
—J. Clinton Metcalf, 62, former representative to the Maine Legislature and for 40 years engaged in business in this town, died Sunday. He suffered a stroke Friday and did not regain consciousness.

Mr. Metcalf was born in New Portland, April 14, 1872, and completed his schooling at Bridgton Academy and at a Portland business college. He engaged in the shoe business here when 21 years old, and after bringing the first automobile to this town engaged in that line of business. He had served on the school board and was a worker in the Republican party for some years, representing this town in the Legislature in 1925 and 1927. He was at one time treasurer of the Unitarian Church, a director of the Chamber of Commerce and treasurer of the Franklin Memorial Hospital, and at the time of his death a trustee of the hospital and a director of the People's National Bank. He was a 32nd degree Mason.

His wife, Mrs. Ethel Walker Metcalf, formerly of Bethel, and a daughter, Mrs. Theresa E. Mitchell of Augusta, survive her.

MARVIN CLINTON MEYER

ORONO — Marvin Clinton Meyer, 84, professor emeritus of zoology at the University of Maine, died unexpectedly April 3, 1992, at a Bangor hospital. He was born Dec. 20, 1907, in Jackson, Mo., the son of Louis F. and Odessa (Ates) Meyer. He was graduated from Southeast Missouri State Teachers College (now Southeast Missouri State University) in 1932. In 1936, he received a M.A. degree from Ohio State University, which he had attended summers while he taught high school near his home. There he met his wife, a fellow student. In 1939, he received a PhD from the University of Illinois. He taught at the University of Kentucky, 1939 to 1941; and a year at Rutgers

1967-68. During his academic career, Meyer held leadership posts in professional capacities: section editor (Annelida) for biological abstracts, 1961-81; member of advisory committee, Smithsonian Institution, USNM, Oceanographic Sorting Center (Annelida), 1965-90; member of national screening committee, International Education for Fulbright-Hays Grants, 1967-68 and 1972; editorial consultant, Journal of Parasitology, 1971-73. His research interests are amply reflected in more than 50 refereed scientific papers published in American and foreign journals. He is best known for "Essentials of Parasitology", coauthored with the late O. Wilford Olsen. First published in 1971 and now in its fifth edition, the textbook is widely recognized as a standard work for students of parasitology. Meyer was a member of Mechanics Lodge No. 66 AF & AM of Orono, the Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Bangor. An active church member, he served terms on the boards of deacons and trustees of the Church of

Universal Fellowship, Orono. He is survived by his beloved wife, Elizabeth of Orono; two daughters, Susan Meyer Durst of Zornheim, Germany, and Annette Meyer Horn of Dover, N.H.; a son, Clinton of Wilmington, N.C.; nine grandchildren; and a brother, Joe Lynn of Jackson, Mo.; and numerous friends and associates. Memorial services will be held 10 a.m. Tuesday, April 7, at the Church of Universal Fellowship, Orono. Friends who wish may make donations in his memory to the Marvin C. Eastn rt, Nov. 17.—William S. Milton, 83, died Wednesday noon at his home after a few weeks' illness. He had been active in business in this city during the past 52 years when he first came here from Weymouth, N. S., where he was born.

Arriving at this frontier seaport in 1832 he opened a variety store which was destroyed in the disastrous fire of 1886 which wiped out the entire business section. After the rebuilding of the town he opened a large variety store in the Masonic Block and conducted it until 1911 when he sold out to take over the management of the former Eastport Dry Goods Store in the same block. Thirteen years ago he opened a shoe store and operated it until a short time ago when taken ill.

Mr. Milton was a leading Democrat and was elected mayor in 1901. He was a representative to the legislature, city tax collector, overseer of the poor and in 1913 was appointed postmaster by President Wilson and held the local office eight years.

In fraternal societies he held many high offices in Masonic orders, Elks, Odd Fellows, was active in the Chamber of Commerce, and a leading member of Christ Episcopal Church.

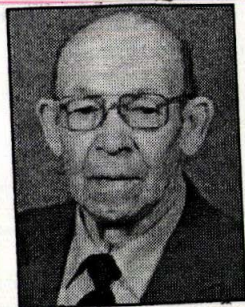
