Calais, July 16 .- Dr. Walter Nathan Miner, 76, founder of the Calais Hospital, former mayor of Calais and Washington County state senator and representative, died Thursday. Doctor Miner was born at Mount Whatley, N. B., in 1872, the son of Nathan and Celia Carter Miner. He attended the schools in his home town and was graduated from Fredericton Normal School, teaching for a time after his graduation. He was graduated from Baltimore Medical School and took a postgraduate course at Johns Hopkins University, followed by later work at Guys Hospital in London and the University of Edinburgh. In 1899, Doctor Miner began the practice of medicine in Calais, later establishing his own hospital, which he continued until 1946, when he presented it to the city of Calais. A member of the Maine Chamber of Commerce and the Maine Publicity Bureau, he was a Mason and a member of Anah Temple, Mystic Shrine, of Bangor.

Doctor Miner was a member of the Second Baptist Church and chairman of the Executive Board at the time of his death, also president of Calais Industries, Inc., and first vice president of Calais Federal Savings and Loan Association.
