WOOLWICH — Woodrow E. Miller, 84, of River Road died Friday, June 22, 2001, at Mid Coast Hospital in Brunswick.

He was born in Woolwich on April 1, 1917, a son of Charles F. and Louise Humphrey Miller. He was educated in Woolwich schools and attended Morse High School.

"He always harbored the belief that he would eventually own his own business," said his son, Thimi Mina. "After the last of his three children was about to start college, he took that risk. He said, 'I know about paper, I can do printing.'"

Mr. Mina chose the Middle Street location just when the long-dormant Old Port area nearby started to return to life. "That was when the more popular business locations were higher up on Congress Street," said his son, John Mina.

At first, the business was part of the national chain of Curry Copy Centers. He soon bought the store from the chain and added full-service printing, expanding into the whole first floor of the Middle Street building.

He was successful because of his friendliness, honesty and high-quality workmanship, according to his sons. "He believed that he could make do with quality work and treating the customers decently," said his son,

Thimi. "It worked and he was prosperous."

"His customers became his friends," said John. "Sometimes they just came in to talk."

In the early 1980s Mr. Mina bought the ornate brick structure the shop was in and, using old photographs, he recently restored it as closely as he could to the original 1903 architecture. Long the headquarters of Maine Savings Bank during the first half of this century, the historic building's address was changed in recent years to 10 City Center.

Calais, July 16.—Dr. Walter Nathan Miner, 76, founder of the Calais Hospital, former mayor of Calais and Washington County state senator and representative, died Thursday.

Doctor Miner was born at Mount Whatley, N. B., in 1872, the son of Nathan and Celia Carter Miner. He attended the schools in his home town and was graduated from Frederickton Normal School, teaching for a time after his graduation.

He was graduated from Baltimore Medical School and took a postgraduate course at Johns Hopkins University, followed by later work at Guys Hospital in London and the University of Edinburgh.

In 1899, Doctor Miner began the practice of medicine in Calais, later establishing his own hospital, which he continued until 1946, when he presented it to the city of Calais.

A member of the Maine Chamber of Commerce and the Maine Publicity Bureau, he was a Mason and a member of Anah Temple, Mystic Shrine, of Bangor.

Doctor Miner was a member of the Second Baptist Church and chairman of the Executive Board at the time of his death, also president of Calais Industries, Inc., and first vice president of Calais Federal Savings and Loan Association.

He married Miss Estella Delahay of Baltimore, who died in 1929. In 1930 he married Miss Hanna Harris of Cranton, Pa., who survives him.

Also surviving are three children, Dr. John Miner, a practicing dentist of Calais; Mrs. Uriah (Elizabeth) Brist, of Front Royal, Va.; Mrs. Wal-
