George P. Milner, Sr., 73, died unexpectedly in Castine May 19, 1981. He was born in Jonesport Oct. 18, 1907, the son of Albert and Elsie (Norton) Milner. He graduated from Eastern Maine Normal School in Castine and received his B.A. and M.Ed. from the University of Maine at Orono. From 1930-1934 he was principal and teacher at Islesford Grammar School; from 1934-42 he was teacher and coach at Stetson Grammar School in Northeast Harbor; from 1942-45 he was inspector and group leader at Pratt-Whitney in East Hartford, Conn. Mr. Milner serv-

ed from 1945-52 as principal, teacher and coach at Derby Grammar School in Milo; from 1952-58 as principal of Houlton Junior High School in Houlton and from 1958-63 he was superintendent of schools in Houlton.
