CHAUNCEY LEEDS MITCHELL. JR.

Chauncey Leeds Mitchell, Jr., 90, passed away Thurs., Oct. 5, while visiting his daughter in Dartmouth, Mass. Members of his family have been summer residents of Christmas Cove since the late 1800s and he lived year-round in Christmas Cove for 35 years, being an active member of the sea-faring community.

Mr. Mitchell was born in Greenfield, Mass., on March 13, 1905, to Amy (Bagley) and Chauncey

Mitchell.

Before moving permanently to Christmas Cove in 1955, he had resided in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., Hyde Park, Mass., and Winchester. Mass.

In 1930 he married Alexia Dunbar. They had two children: Chauncey the 3rd, who died at the age of three, and Suzanne, who now resides in Dartmouth.

His working career included General Electric in Lynn, Mass., The and Merchant Marines, owning/operating Leeds Ice Cream in Wakefield, Mass., for 15 years.

Alexia died in 1974. In 1976, he married Vera Wright Austin of Waterville and Bar Harbor.

Mr. Mitchell's greatest passion was of the sea and ships. From being an engineer on Army Transport ships bringing troops home after World War II, to traveling as a passenger on freighters during most winters of the 1970s and 1980s, he traveled the world many times over. He also worked for the Coast Guard Auxiliary, put in 57 years of dedicated service for the United States Power Squadron, many years as harbormaster of South Bristol, and he owned various boats throughout his life.

He frequently recalled his childhood journeys to Christmas Cove from Boston. By family car it would take an entire day, frequently having to stop to change tires, wait for ferries to cross the Kennebec and Sheepscot Rivers, or make repairs on the horse and buggy dirt path between Damariscotta and South Bristol. By sea he would take the overnight steamer from Boston to Bath, then the coastal steamer from

Bath to Christmas Cove.

More recently, winters were spent in Punta Gorda, Fla., with his wife Vera, and summers in Christmas

Cove.

Survivors include his wife Vera; a brother Henry B. Mitchell of Punta Gorda, Fla.; his daughter, Suzanne Lindblom, son-in-law, Edgar Lindblom, grandchildren, Scott, Kristin and Jenny, and greatgrandson Jack. He was also the brother of the late Alice M. Smith of Winchester, Mass.




