BELGRADE, Oct. 4 (Special)—John Clair Minot, 68, author and former literary editor of the Boston Herald, who died at his home in Dover, Mass., Friday night, was a native of this town.

From the little old red school-house near the farm here, he went to Cony High School, Augusta, about a dozen miles away, where he was editor of the school paper and played on the first high school football team organized in Maine.

At Bowdoin College, where he graduated in 1896, he was a Deke, a member of Phi Beta Kappa, editor of the Orient winner of many prizes.

graduation he spent six months in the Augusta office of Leslie C. Cornish, former Chief Justice of the Maine Superior Court.

He did not follow law, however, and in 1908 went from the Kennebec Journal to the Youth's Companion in Boston and thence to the Boston Herald.

He spent a year in France during the World War and resumed his editorial work upon his return, being transferred to books a few months later.

John Henry Minott, 76, son of Capt. Davis Bradbury Minott of Topsham, one of the masters of the old Sewall sailing fleet of Bath and a resident of Portland nearly all his life, died Sunday in his home, 381 Cumberland Avenue.

Mr. Minott left Topsham at the age of 18 years to make a trip to the West Coast and to England with his father. When he returned he came to this city and entered the employ of H. H. Nevins, wholesale grocery firm on Fore Street. He remained with this concern until it closed out in 1902 when he was treasurer.

Mr. Minott then became employed as a sample clerk by Parker and Thomes, wholesale dry goods firm, remaining until it closed out 10 years ago. He retired from active business at that time.

Survivors include his wife Vera; a brother Henry B. Mitchell of Punta Gorda, Fla.; his daughter, Suzanne Lindblom, son-in-law, Edgar Lindblom, grandchildren, Scott, Kristin and Jenny, and great-grandson Jack. He was also the brother of the late Alice M. Smith of Winchester, Mass.
