Radcliffe G. Mitchell, 78, of Lake Shore Drive, Auburn, former Auburn city manager, died early Thursday morning at Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston.

Born in Lewiston, Nov. 3, 1903, the son of Joseph and Maude Golder Mitchell, he was educated in Lewiston schools, graduating from Lewiston High School in 1921 and from Beverly College at Boston in 1923.

Mr. Mitchell was married in New York City in 1931 to the former Shirley Haskell and she died in Auburn on Sept. 13, 1979.

Mr. Mitchell was always employed as an accountant and owned and operated his own business for many years. He was city manager of Auburn from July 3, 1941, until Dec. 9, 1943.

former federal energy executive

KENNEBUNK — Robert W. Mitchell, 75, of the Port Road died Saturday at the Maine Medical Center in Portland.

He was born in Orono, a son of Ralph and Emma Williams Mitchell, and graduated from Parsonfield Seminary in East Parsonfield, N.H. An engineering major, he attended the University of Tennessee and graduated from the Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, N.Y. He was a graduate of the School of Foreign Service at Georgetown University and a 1976 graduate of the Federal Executive Institute.

Mr. Mitchell was an international energy executive with Esso East and served in Africa, the Indian subcontinent and Southeast Asia. Returning to the United States, he served as energy adviser to the governor of New Hampshire. He was appointed administrator of Federal Energy Administration's Region 1 office in Boston in 1974 and was responsible for carrying out federal energy policy and programs in the New England region. He later worked for Northern Energy and retired in 1983.

He moved to Kennebunk in 1991 from Guilford, N.H. He was a member of Arundel Lodge of Masons in Kennebunkport, Trinity Episcopal Church of Kennebunk Beach and served on the chapel committee of the church. He was active in the conversation committee of the town and was active in the "Meals on Wheels" program.

Surviving are his wife of 42 years, M. Patricia Chase Mitchell of Kennebunk; one son, Brooks B. of Marlboro, Vt.; two brothers, Dr. Alan B. Mitchell of Alameda, Calif., and Ralph Mitchell of Pittsfield, Mass., and two granddaughters.
