

ing Section, Jan. 19, 1885, son of the late ex-Mayor William W. Mitchell of Deering, former Portland real estate agent.



## Former Police Chief At Westbrook Dies

WESTBROOK, Feb. 15—Willis P. Mitchell, 80, of 667 Main St., one of the first men to be appoited to the first regular police department, died in his home today.

Mr. Mitchell was chief of the department several times during his tenure from 1905 until his retirement in 1941. In 1907 he was reappointed by Mayor Harry F. G. Hay as the city took patrolmen's jobs out of politics.




