CAPE ELIZABETH — Capt. Vernon S. Mitchell, former president of the Portland Marine Society, died yesterday at age 81 in a South Portland nursing home.

Mr. Mitchell, of 40 Linwood St., was employed by Texaco Oil Co. for 43 years and was a marine representative in the oil company's marine department for 34 years before retiring in 1965.

He was born in Bath, son of Robert and Amelia Snow Mitchell.

Mr. Mitchell went to sea on sailing ships built in Bath in the early 1900s. His first voyage was made at 17, on the first steel-hulled four-master, the Bath-built Edward R. Sewall. He was one of the last people to go to sea in a square-rigged ship.

He was a member of the Masons in Bath, the Kora Temple Shrine in Lewiston, the Maine Marine Society and the Propeller Club. He was named president of the Marine Society in 1965.

He was married to Susan Fletcher on Aug. 22, 1927.

In addition to his wife, he leaves a niece, Mrs. Amelia Ann Mitchell Moore of Provo, Utah.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday at Curtis and Hill Funeral Home, 942 Washington St., Bath. Burial will be in Oak Grove Cemetery, Bath.

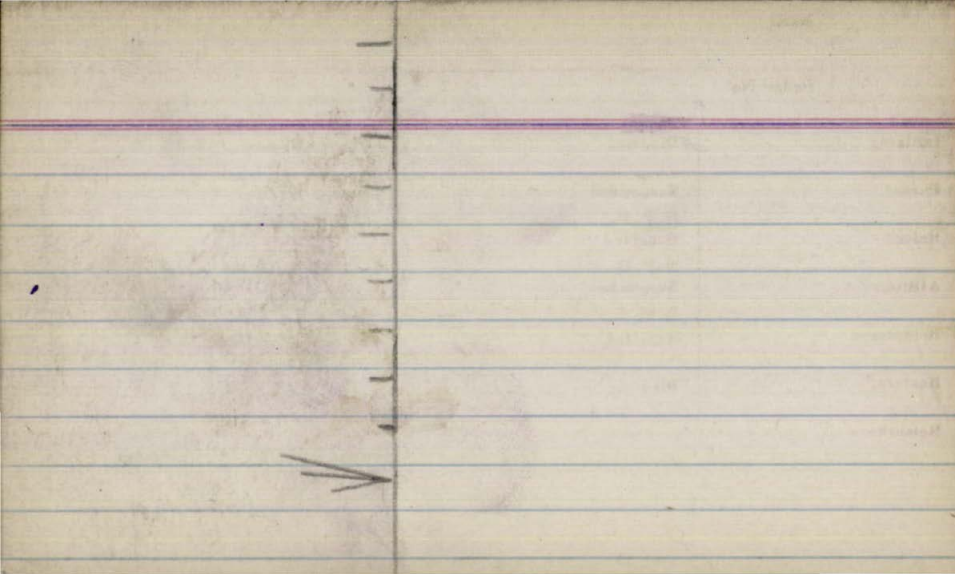
