Pittsfield, Mach 3.—Col. Walter G. Morrill, 94, for more than 50 years a promoter of horse races in Maine and the last surviving veteran of the Civil War in Pittsfield, died at his home here today.

Colonel Morrill was born at Williamsburg, the son of the late Aaron and Eliza Willard Morrill. He enlisted April 26, 1861, in Company A of the Sixth Maine Infantry. He served throughout the war and rose from the rank of private to colonel. He was wounded three times and was awarded a Congressional Medal of Honor for bravery at the Battle of Rappahannock Station.

Colonel Morrill conducted his first horse race at Dexter in 1876 and since that time has conducted races at Bangor, Dover-Foxcroft, Skowhegan, Fairfield, Gardiner, Pittsfield, Dexter and Waterville. He paid more than \$100,000 in prizes and was the first promoter in Maine to put on a race with women drivers.

He had owned more than 40 horses up until his retirement from active participation in horse racing in 1927. Maine racemen had honored Colonel Morrill on his birthday since his retirement. He was believed to be one of the oldest Masons in Maine.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Adelaide Brown of Pittsfield.

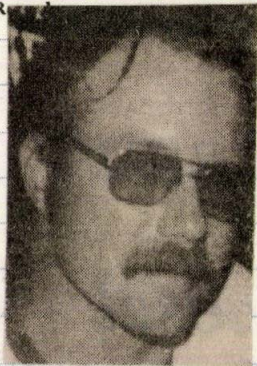
