BREWER — Harry H. Morrison, 83, of 223 Chamberlain St., Brewer, died June 24, 1981, at a Brewer convalescent home. He was born in South Brewer Oct. 24, 1897, son of Hugh and Grace (Mansur) Morrison. He was an Army veteran of World War I, a member of the Essex Street Free Baptist Church, Mystic Lodge AF & AM of Hampden for over 50 years, and a former member of the American Legion, Brewer. He was an ardent and enthusiastic athlete as player, fan and student. He went to work in 1914 in one of the world's largest sulphite pulp

mills. He returned to Maine to the Eastern Corp. after serving in World War I. For 10 years he performed many jobs in the paper mill office and cost department becoming the assistant manager of the former in 1928 and manager in 1938. During this time, he was able to manage the Eastern Athletic Association for two years. He was manager of the order department from 1939 to 1942 after which he was transferred to Chicago as district sales manager. After serving in this field, he returned to the mill in Brewer as advertising manager, a position he held until his retirement in 1964.

He was predeceased by his wife, Lena Morrison, in 1979. Surviving are three sons, Wendell Morrison of Lincoln, R.I., Roland Morrison of Simsbury, Conn., and Sherman Morrison of East Gramby, Conn.; a sister, Miss Jennie Morrison of Brewer; eight grandchildren; several great-grandchildren; nieces, nephews and cousins. Memorial services will be held 10 a.m. Saturday at Essex Street Free Baptist Church in Bangor with the Rev. Herman Gerrish, interim pastor officiating. Burial will follow at Woodlawn Cemetery, Brewer.
