GORHAM — Albert Erlon Mosher Sr., 99, a retired dairy farmer, state legislator and a descendant of some of Gorham's first settlers, died Tuesday in a Portland hospital.

Mr. Mosher was a son of Albert and Mary Waterhouse Mosher. He was born and lived his entire life in the family farmhouse at 424 Mosher Road. The 140-acre farm is at Routes 25 and 237, known as Mosher's Corner and named for Mr. Mosher's ancestors.

PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

The Mosher's came to the area in 1738 and built a log cabin near the farm. They settled in the current farm site in 1771 and built the large Federal-style family home in 1810.

Mr. Mosher graduated from Westbrook High School and received an agriculture degree in 1914 from the University of New Hampshire. At UNH he set a school record in the 440-yard dash and participated in the Boston Athletic Association Games.

Mr. Mosher was a former town road commissioner and served on the budget committee and Republican Town Committee. He served eight years in the Maine House of Representatives during the 1960s and early 1970s.

He was a past master of Harmony Masonic Lodge and deacon emeritus of Westbrook-Warren Congregational Church. In his retirement he built and restored furniture.

His wife of 56 years, Emma Abbott Mosher, died in 1983.

Surviving are two sons, Albert E. Jr. and Abbott W., both of Gorham; seven grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
