Dr. Moulton was born at Concord, and at an early age moved with his parents to North New Portland. He was educated in the schools of that town and graduated from Westbrook Seminary in 1881, and from Bowdoin Medical School in 1884. He first practiced medicine at St. Albans, and some years later moved to Hartland where he had practiced since. In his more than half-century of medical practice at Hartland, Dr. Moulton some years ago estimated that he had brought more than 2,000 babies into the world. A typical country practitioner, Dr. Moulton was not only physician, but also friend and confident to hundreds in this community. He served as president of Medical Association in 923, and received that organizaion's 50-year medal in 1934. He Iso served several terms as presilent and secretary of the Someret County Medical Association. and served more than a score of years as school physician. An early hobby of Dr. Moulton's n experimenting with telephones leveloped years later into the Hartland and St. Albans phone Company, of which Dr. Moulton was principal owner. He was also instrumental in the organization of the first electric light company at Hartland, later selling out his holdings. In 1933 he organized Hartland's first hospital. Dr. Moulton was a trustee of Institute and Maine Central Hartland Academy.

"He was a very devoted father," said a daughter, Jeanne Weils. "He was always good about taking his children with him and doing things," she said. Wells remembers going lobstering, fishing, hunting and bowling with her

father when she was growing up. In 1988, Mr. Moulton moved to Panther Pond in Raymond, where he liked the quiet, natural setting, "He enjoyed sitting in his chair and being able to look out over the pond," his wife said.

Mr. Moulton also enjoyed caning chairs, a skill he learned from a neighbor at his native Cape Neddick in York after retiring from the Portsmouth Naval Shipvard.

"As the gentieman became more busy doing chairs for other people, he would send extra customers up to Elroy," his wife recalled. She said it usually took about eight hours to finish one chair seat, and said Mr. Moulton was extremely patient.

After moving to Raymond, he would sometimes return to York and sell chairs he had caned at a flea market. The flea market gave him and his wife a chance to visit with friends they had made while living at Cape Neddick.

Mr. Moulton enjoyed bowling and was a member of

the Raymond Men's Bowling League.

Born a son of Adrian B. Sr. and Emma J. Rizzo Moulton, he was a 1943 graduate of York High School. and served in the Navy from 1943 to 1946 in the South Pacific on a repair ship.

Mr. Moulton was a 1952 graduate of the Portsmouth Naval Shipvard apprentice program as a sheet metal worker. He later worked in the architectural design department, retiring in 1978 as a production and

design liaison.

Mr. Moulton had lived at Cape Neddick for 63 years before moving here. He had worked as service clerk at the North Windham Country Store and at the

Shop & Save supermarket in North Windham. Mr. Moulton was a member of the Cape Neddick Baptist Church. He was a past master and chaplain of St. Aspinguid Masonic Lodge of York and a past worthy patron of Fadette Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.



Sebago Lake, Nov. 4.—The firstrural mail carrier to be appointed in Maine and one of the original three in the United States, will be buried here Sunday.

Funeral services will be held in the village church for Gilbert E. Moulton, 85, who retired in 1930 after serving for 33 years as carrier from the local station. Masonic rites will be performed and interment will be in the village cemetery.

Mr. Moulton, who died Thursday, was born here, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John P. Moulton. He received his education in the Standish schools and became assistant to his father, who was Maine Central Railroad station agent. He resigned this position in 1896 to become carrier on the first rural route established in this State, and was one of the Government's oldest carriers at retirement.

Two Maryland men became carriers at about the same time as Mr. Moulton who first used a bicycle in his delivery, horses and buggles being rather expensive. It was a tough job pushing a bike over the rough country roads with a load of mail, and in time he acquired a team. Before he retired he had for some time used an automobile.

Mr. Moulton leaves two sons, John L., Waterville, and Seth A., South Portland; two daughters, Mrs. Addie Frost, South Paris, and Mrs. Edith Witham, with whom he made his home, eight grandchildren and ten greatgrandchildren.


