Rolf B. Motz, 45, superintendent of schools at Falmouth, Cumberland and Yarmouth and widely-known in Maine educational circles, died Monday in his home, 1705 Forest Avenue, after an illness of six months.

Hartland, Dec. 8.—Dr. Charles A. Moulton, 86, former president of the Maine Medical Association, and a practicing physician for more than 60 years, died suddenly at his home here Saturday night.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at the Methodist Church. The Rev. Ernest Smith will officiate.

Dr. Moulton was born at Concord, and at an early age moved with his parents to North New Portland. He was educated in the schools of that town and was graduated from Westbrook Seminary in 1881, and from Bowdoin Medical School in 1884. He first practiced medicine at St. Albans, and some years later moved to Hartland where he had practiced since.

In his more than half-century of medical practice at Hartland, Dr. Moulton some years ago estimated that he had brought more than 2,000 babies into the world. A typical country practitioner, Dr. Moulton was not only physician, but also friend and confidant to hundreds in this community.

He served as president of the Maine Medical Association in 1923, and received that organization's 50-year medal in 1934. He also served several terms as president and secretary of the Somerset County Medical Association, and served more than a score of years as school physician.

An early hobby of Dr. Moulton's in experimenting with telephones developed years later into the Hartland and St. Albans Telephone Company, of which Dr. Moulton was principal owner. He was also instrumental in the organization of the first electric light company at Hartland, later selling out his holdings. In 1933 he organized Hartland's first hospital.

Dr. Moulton was a trustee of Maine Central Institute and of Hartland Academy.

He was prominent in Masonic and Odd Fellows circles.

He is survived by a daughter, Miss Ina M. Moulton of Hartland; a son, Dr. Arthur Moulton of Auburn; two grandchildren, and a sister, Mrs. Ethel Windsor of Hartland.

Moulton specialized in the practice of corporation law and served as attorney and clerk for the Portland Water District since 1906.

Mr. and Mrs. Moulton had just returned to their home, 259 Vaughan Street, after passing the Winter in Florida.

Moulton was born Sept. 16, 1871, at Falmouth, son of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel O. Moulton. He received his early education in Falmouth and Cape Elizabeth Schools and was graduated from Westbrook Seminary in 1888. He subsequently was graduated from Yale University Law School in 1897 and taught there for a year before returning to Maine to practice.

His first wife, Etta Knight Moulton, died in 1911; two daughters of this marriage survive. In 1918 he married Helen Leavitt Moulton.

Survivors besides his widow, are

the Free Mrs. O. O. seven Jersey cattle.

Edward Bailey Moulton, 93, a local banker and civic leader, formerly of the Lafayette Townhouse died Wednesday at a local nursing home after a short illness.

7-5-1989

He was born in Monson, a son of Lorenzo and Alma Bailey Moulton, and graduated from Edward Little High School, Auburn, where he was active in basketball and baseball.

He attended Bates College, Lewiston, where he played football for two years before enlisting in the Navy in June 1917. He attended Navy Cadet School at Harvard College, graduating in February 1918.

After a tour of duty he returned to Naval Cadet School as a Lieutenant, J.G., and an instructor. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Bates College in the class of 1919.

In 1919 he moved to New York City and worked in the foreign department of the National Bank of Commerce. In 1922 he moved to Portland, where he worked for the Fidelity Trust Co., and in 1929 he became cashier at the York National Bank in Saco.

He returned to Portland in 1933 as cashier of the National Bank of Commerce of Portland, where he eventually became president. After the merger of the National Bank of Commerce with the Maine National Bank, Mr. Moulton served as executive vice president and director.



He served with the Portland Renewal Authority from 1952-72, and was a former treasurer of the American Red Cross. He was director of the Portland Gas Company from 1950-1980, and was also a director of the Mutual Fire Insurance Company, Saco.

Mr. Moulton was a member of the Fraternity Club, the Maine Historical Society, the Caldwell American Legion Post, the Masons, the Society of Mayflower Descendants and the First Parish Unitarian Universalist Church. He was a member and former vice president of the the Portland Rotary Club.

He was a longtime resident of Chebeague Island, where he was a member, former treasurer and president of the Chebeague Island Golf Club.

His first wife, the former Helen Marguerite Freeman, died in 1940.

Surviving are his second wife, Margaret Knowles Moulton of Portland; a daughter, Ruth Moulton Ragan of Lincoln, Mass.; a son, Sumner E. Moulton, M.D., of Portland; a stepdaughter, Joan Holmes Perry of Brunswick; three grandchildren, two step-grandchildren, four great-grandchildren and a step-great-grandchild.

## Elroy B. Moulton

outdoorsman, 'very devoted father'

RAYMOND — Elroy B. Moulton, 71, a long-time outdoorsman, died Tuesday at Maine Medical Center in Portland.

Mr. Moulton enjoyed hunting and fishing, both in Maine and New Hampshire. He would often go on excursions with Chandler Dufresne. They had been friends since their teens, said Ruth Moulton, Mr. Moulton's wife.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

The two men had their favorite spots for hunting and fishing, but in recent years some of those spots had turned into housing developments, she said.

"He was a very devoted father," said a daughter, Jeanne Wells. "He was always good about taking his children with him and doing things," she said. Wells remembers going lobstering, fishing, hunting and bowling with her

father when she was growing up.

In 1988, Mr. Moulton moved to Panther Pond in Raymond, where he liked the quiet, natural setting. "He enjoyed sitting in his chair and being able to look out over the pond," his wife said.

Mr. Moulton also enjoyed caning chairs, a skill he learned from a neighbor at his native Cape Neddick in York after retiring from the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard.

"As the gentleman became more busy doing chairs for other people, he would send extra customers up to Elroy," his wife recalled. She said it usually took about eight hours to finish one chair seat, and said Mr. Moulton was extremely patient.

After moving to Raymond, he would sometimes return to York and sell chairs he had caned at a flea market. The flea market gave him and his wife a chance to visit with friends they had made while living at Cape Neddick.

Mr. Moulton enjoyed bowling and was a member of the Raymond Men's Bowling League.

Born a son of Adrian B. Sr. and Emma J. Rizzo Moulton, he was a 1943 graduate of York High School, and served in the Navy from 1943 to 1946 in the South Pacific on a repair ship.

Mr. Moulton was a 1952 graduate of the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard apprentice program as a sheet metal worker. He later worked in the architectural design department, retiring in 1978 as a production and design liaison.

Mr. Moulton had lived at Cape Neddick for 63 years before moving here. He had worked as service clerk at the North Windham Country Store and at the Shop & Save supermarket in North Windham.

Mr. Moulton was a member of the Cape Neddick Baptist Church. He was a past master and chaplain of St. Aspinquid Masonic Lodge of York and a past worthy patron of Fadette Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.

Survivors include his wife, Ruth Irene Fogg Moulton; a son, Bradley S. of Cape Neddick; two daughters, Jeanne M. Wells of Rochester, N.Y., and Joyce I. Moulton of Durham; two brothers, Adrian B. Jr. and Myron, both of Cape Neddick; a sister, Audrey Hollings of Saginaw, Mich.; six grandchildren and a great-grandson.

**Sebago Lake, Nov. 4.**—The first rural mail carrier to be appointed in Maine and one of the original three in the United States, will be buried here Sunday.

Funeral services will be held in the village church for Gilbert E. Moulton, 85, who retired in 1930 after serving for 33 years as carrier from the local station. Masonic rites will be performed and interment will be in the village cemetery.

Mr. Moulton, who died Thursday, was born here, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John P. Moulton. He received his education in the Standish schools and became assistant to his father, who was Maine Central Railroad station agent. He resigned this position in 1896 to become carrier on the first rural route established in this State, and was one of the Government's oldest carriers at retirement.

Two Maryland men became carriers at about the same time as Mr. Moulton who first used a bicycle in his delivery, horses and buggies being rather expensive. It was a tough job pushing a bike over the rough country roads with a load of mail, and in time he acquired a team. Before he retired he had for some time used an automobile.

Mr. Moulton leaves two sons, John L., Waterville, and Seth A., South Portland; two daughters, Mrs. Addie Frost, South Paris, and Mrs. Edith Witham, with whom he made his home, eight grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.
