SEBAGO LAKE, Feb. 15 — Simon W. Moulton, 56, attorney and orchardist, died yesterday in a Portland hospital after a long illness. He was born in Standish Sept. 5, 1898, son of the late Lewis W. and Georgia B. Moulton, attended Standish schools and was graduated from the University of Maine in 1918 and from Harvard Law School in 1922.

Mr. Moulton was a member of the Cumberland County Bar Association and practiced law in Portland many years. He had held legal positions with the Home Owners' Loan Corp., Portland, the Office of Price Administration, Portland Pipe Line Corp. and was serving as negotiating attorney for the New England Division, Army Engineers, when ill health forced his retirement in 1952.

He was a past master of Standish Lodge, AF&AM, Eagle Royal Arch Chapter of Westbrook, past president of the Standish Kiwanis Club and a former town selectman and moderator.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Rachel L. Moulton; a son, Willard R. Moulton, Portland, and three daughters, Mrs. Robert White, Sebago Lake, Mrs. Aaron Nelson, Orono, and Miss Ruth Moulton, Boston.

GEORGETOWN — Thomas S. Moulton, retired merchant marine captain, died Sunday at a hospital in Burlington, Mass. He was 68.

He was born in Portland, a son of Leroy D. and Gertrude Wilde Moulton.

He graduated from Lawrenceville Preparatory School in New Jersey, and attended the University of Wichita in Kansas.

Mr. Moulton was a lieutenant commander in the Navy during World War II.

He was commanding officer of five Naval vessels and was second senior officer in Manchuria, an officer in charge of all maintenance and repairs of vessels engaged in the lifts of Chinese armies from Ceylon to Manchuria.

Mr. Moulton retired from the Navy in 1946 and a year later joined the merchant marine until 1950.

He later worked for Mack Truck Co. and Arthur D. Little Research and Development Co. in Boston.

He founded Moulton Associates of New York City and Georgetown.

He rejoined the merchant marine in 1963 and retired as captain in 1985.

He was a member of the Penbay Amateur Radio Club, the Council of American Master Mariners, the Masons, Dunlap Commandery, Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston, Montgomery and St. Bernard Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, the Marine Square Club and Harvard Faculty Club. He was a supporter of the Maine Maritime Museum.

Surviving are his wife, Julia Frey Moulton of Georgetown; a son, Rolf of Pepperpike, Ohio; three daughters, Samantha J. Moulton of Georgetown, Massachusetts, Lamadrid of Astoria, N.Y., and Gail Leili, also of Astoria, and seven grandsons.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at Curran and Hill Funeral Home, 942 Washington St., Bath. Burial will be in Mountain View Cemetery.

CARL A. MUELLER

Carl A. Mueller, 69, of Friendship, died suddenly Nov. 13 in Mooresville, N.C.

He was born March 28, 1935 in Neptune, N.J., the only child of the late Albert and Ruth Woolley Mueller of Manasquan, N.J.

Carl graduated from Manasquan, N.J. High School in 1953. The caption in his yearbook said: "A future flower grower is he; Carl's friends will never cease to be." He joined his father and mother in operating a landscaping business. At 19, he became engaged to Susan May Firman and built their first home. The couple was married Aug. 28, 1954 and celebrated their 50th anniversary this past summer.

A successful and innovative businessman, he eventually became sole owner of Mueller Nurseries, and was expert in landscape design and planning. He recently wrote and published a booklet, "Landscaping Your Life".

He was an avid Boy Scout, and was a troop leader for 25 years. He frequently devised challenges for his boys. During the summer of 1968, his troop earned a special merit badge by completing a 50-mile canoe trip in Maine from the Androscoggin River to Friendship Harbor. Mr. and Mrs. Mueller and their close friends Caroline and Bill Zuber, now of Friendship, assisted in the logistics of getting 12 canoes, 2 vans, and 25 boys up and down the rivers and bays of coastal Maine in five days.

While working in New Jersey, Mr. Mueller and Bill Zuber worked together on many ideas and projects. They designed and built a 100-ton marine elevator; planned and built boats; rebuilt Zuber's 1902 Friendship Sloop and sailed it to Maine for Sloop Days, and then sailed it to its new home in Friendship in 1973. The Muellers followed the Zuber family to Friendship in 1981.

Mr. Mueller had prefabricated a little cabin in New Jersey and transported it to Friendship; he and his wife lived in it while he built their second home on Pine Cove Lane. He quickly adapted to his new surroundings, doing landscaping, snowplowing, carpentry, painting and solving problems for his neighbors. He worked as a boat captain and supervised maintenance at the Hurricane Island Outward Bound School for 11 years. During his tenure, the school expanded its bases in Newry as well as on several islands. His expertise in improvising solutions to the problems of island and mainland logistics and practical land use became legendary, the family said.

He "retired" once again, and continued to design and construct homes, and provide snowplowing, landscaping, and general handyman services, often on a volunteer basis. In 1992, he was elected selectman in Friendship, and continued to solve problems and provide steady leadership to the town.

He was an active member of the Masonic Lodge in Friendship, and a Trustee of the Friendship United Methodist Church. He delighted in telling jokes, and playing harmless tricks on unsuspecting friends. He has been described by a neighbor as someone who knew you needed something done, and would do it before you realized it yourself.

When news of his death reached the town, all town flags were lowered to half-staff, a spontaneous response to the great sense of loss felt by residents.

Survivors include his wife of Friendship; his sons, Keith A. Mueller of Peru, N.Y., Luke Jonathan Eagle of Rockland, and Brett C. Mueller of Mooresville, N.C.; a granddaughter, Kristy Gauthier of Providence, R.I.; a grandson, Alexander Carl Mueller of Mooresville, N.C.; many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins and countless friends.

There will be a private service for the family at Christmas. A public memorial service will be held next year in Friendship and will be announced.
