seven nieces and a nephew.



Mr. Nash founded the Nash Telephone Co. and had 65 customers subscribers by 1900. He developed his pioneer firm serving a dozen or more Lincoln County communities after installing the town's first telephone in his home as a link to the railroad station in Newcastle, where he worked as station agent.

Mr. Nash's other business ventures over the years included a garage and the American Express Agency here. With the late Dr. Fred Albee he built the town of Nakomis in Florida.

Mr. Nash sold his interest in the telephone firm some years ago and moved to Florida.


A native of Warren, he was born July 20, 1873, the son of Henderson and Rachael Wade Nash.
