BRUNSWICK - Wilbur R. Myers, 82, of 41 Thompson St., formerly of Bethel and Holiday, Fla., died Saturday at Winship Green Nursing Center, Bath, after a long illness.

He was born in Orono, son of Angus and Mary Ann Crowe Myers, graduated from Orono High School and from Maine School of Commerce, Bangor (now Husson College).

On March 23, 1935, he married Pauline Browne in Portsmouth, N.H.

Mr. Myers taught at Smyrna High School for a year before teaching at Gould Academy. He taught business courses from 1931 to 1942, when he became bursar, a position he maintained until his retirement in 1972.

He also coached skiing, baseball and girls basketball. In 1931, he assisted in the introduction of football to Gould, though only two students had even seen a game.

During the summers, he managed operation of the National Training Laboratories, a division of the National Education Association, for the first 24 years that they were in residence at Gould.

He was a member and former deacon of West Paris Congregational Church, a 50-year member and past master of the Masonic Lodge of Bethel, a former trustee for Bethel Savings Bank, a former business manager for the National Training Laboratories and was one of the founding corporators and the first treasurer of Sunday

River Ski Area.

In 1970, he received the Henry Hastings Award for Citizenship.

He was a sportsman and enjoyed fishing. He made an annual trek to Rapid River for more than a quarter of a century.

In 1988, he moved here.

A son, David, died in 1980.
