He studied mechanical engineering at Northeastern University and Franklin Institute. He worked for several paper companies in New England, his last job being with E.C. Jordan Consultants in Portland.

Upon his retirement he worked as a crossing guard for the City of Portland.

He was a member of W. Falmouth Baptist Church where he served as Deacon, Trustee, and Usher. He was also a member of the New Sharon Lodge of Masons, Technical Association of the Pulp and Paper Industry, and the Maine Association of Engineers.

He leaves one nephew, James Jr. of San Antonio, Texas.
