At the time of death, and was a member of Bar Harbor Lodge of Masons.

As a young man, before starting his theological training, he was employed for a time as machinist by the Interborough Rapid Transit Company, New York City.

He later was chauffeur for the late D. C. Blair in New York City during which time his work took him to Europe. It was also during this employment he became a yacht engineer. He leaves a widow. Funeral arrangements are not completed.
