Westbrook, July 1.—Nels F. Nelson, 66, a resident of this city all his life, died this morning in his home, 9 Burton Street, after an illness of several months.

He was manager of the Westbrook store of A. H. Benoit & Company several years and then employed at the Portland store until his last illness.

Mr. Nelson was born in Westbrook Sept. 25, 1880, the son of the late Mads and Maren Smith Nelson, and received his schooling here. He left school in his boyhood to enter the employ of Benoit & Company here, and was associated with the firm for 53 years.

Raymond Lloyd Nelson, 85, passed away on Nov. 29 at Pen Bay Medical Center in Rockport. He was born Feb. 16, 1917 in Concord, Mass., the son of George K. Nelson and Anemarie Larsen Nelson. He attended local schools in Concord, Mass. and graduated from the University of Maine at Orono as a forestry major. He was a veteran of WWII serving with the U.S. Army in Africa and the South Pacific.

Raymond lived and farmed in Vermont before moving to California to work for the California State Park System for four years. He worked at many National Park Service areas across America including Sequoia National Park, Saratoga Battlefield, Mammoth Cave, Washington D.C., Lassen Volcanic National Park, Cal., where he was chief naturalist; Pea Ridge National Military Park in Arkansas; Grand Portage National Historic Site; Mather Training Center in Harpers Ferry, W. V.; and lastly in Washington, D.C. working on designs for the Department of the Interior until he retired to Friendship in 1971.

In Maine he was an organic gardener. He had fruit trees and raised farm animals. He was a very active member of the Friendship United Methodist Church where he served on the administrative board. He was also a lay leader, lay speaker and served on various other boards for the church. He was a member of Meduncook Masonic Lodge in Friendship. He loved nature, birds, plants, wildlife, and bird walks at the Audubon.

Raymond will be remembered as a builder of soils and a steward of land.

He was predeceased by three brothers, George, David and Herbert Nelson. Raymond donated his body to the University of New England in Biddeford.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Linda L. Nelson of Friendship; son, Phillip Lloyd Nelson of Durham, N.C.; grandchildren, David Maguire Nelson of San Francisco, Cal., and Anna Maguire Nelson of Chestnut Hill, Mass.; sister-in-law, Betty Nelson of Bradford, Mass., and Vero Beach, Fla.; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Memorial service will be held in the spring of 2003 at a date and place to be announced. He was born at Howick, Que., Oct. 6, 1873, son of Robert and Mary Anderson Ness. He was graduated from McGill University as a doctor of veterinary science in 1896 and came to Maine to manage the farm of the late James S. Sanborn at Poland.

Dickey Chapter, Rose Croix; and the Maine Consistory of Portland, and Kora Temple of Lewiston. In September 1932 he was made an honorary 33rd degree member of the Supreme Council.

In 1900 Dr. Ness married Jean Dorland Ness of Chicago. She died in 1952.
