AUBURN — Dr. John Anderson Ness, 87, organizer of the Maine Ayrshire Breeders Assn., died Wednesday at a local nursing home.

He was born at Howick, Que., Oct. 6, 1873, son of Robert and Mary Anderson Ness. He was graduated from McGill University as a doctor of veterinary science in 1896 and came to Maine to manage the farm of the late James S. Sanborn at Poland.

In 1904 he purchased the Maplegrove farm in Auburn where he bred horses and purebred Ayrshire cattle until he sold the farm in 1944.

He was a member and director of the New England Milk Producers Association and the first president and director of the Auburn Farmers Production Credit Association.

DR. NESS WAS also a past master of Excelscior Grange at Poland, and past director of the Auburn YMCA, and was both a local councilman and alderman and was a member of the High Street Congregational Church.

Dr. Ness was a member of the Lewiston Lodge of Perfection; Tranquil Lodge of Auburn; Auburn Council, Princes of Jerusalem; the H. H. Dickey Chapter, Rose Croix; and the Maine Consistory of Portland, and Kora Temple of Lewiston. In September 1932 he was made an honorary 33rd degree member of the Supreme Council.

In 1900 Dr. Ness married Jean Dorland Ness of Chicago. She died in 1952.

Survivors are four sons, John M., of Augusta, Robert L. of Newport, Norman R., of Orono, and Gordon B., of Auburn; seven grandchildren, two sisters, Mrs. R.
