BEVERLY HILLS, Fla. — Lawrence M. Newth, a retired osteopathic physician formerly of Portland, Maine, died here April 13.

He was born in Lynn, Mass., a son of Asa and Helen Newth, and graduated from the Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1943.



During Dr. Newth's 47-year career as a general practitioner in Maine, he served as staff chairman at the Osteopathic Hospital of Maine, now Brighton Medical Center, where he also served as interim medical director and a member of the board of trustees.

board member of the Maine Osteopathic Association, and was a life member of the American Osteopathic Association and the American College of General Practitioners.

Dr. Newth was on the development committee forming the College of Osteopathic Medicine at the University of New England. He served as one of the first directors of admissions, and was the first associate dean for student affairs, was associate dean of clinical affairs and was an associate professor. In 1991, Dr. Newth was granted an honorary doctor of science degree by the University of New England.

In 1993, he was appointed by Florida Gov. Lawton Chiles to serve on Florida's Long Term Health Care Ombudsman Council.

Dr. Newth was charter president of the Harrison Lions Club, district governor and an international director of Lions International.

Surviving are his wife, Mildred Newth; two sons, Lawrence M. Jr. of Brandon and Dr. Mark S. of Topeka, Kan.; a sister, Dorothy Dudley of Atlanta; two brothers, Thomas of North Fort Myers and Robert McCormick of Ridgefield, Conn.; and three grandsons.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at Jones, Rich & Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St., Portland, with the Rev. Philip Shearman officiating.
