Nicholson was born on Aug. 19, 1926
Boston, Mass., to Alfred and Jean Nicholson. I
graduated from Roxbury Memorial High Scho
where he excelled intellectually and athletically.

Nicholson was a graduate of Bowdo
College's biggest and best Class of 1950, where he played football ar
competed on the track team. He was named Maine's Outstandir
Athlete, AAU in 1950. A member of the Chi Psi fraternity, Nicholso
served on the fraternity's board of governors from 1953-1978. A
enthusiastic alumnus who won the Polar Bear Award for Outstandin
Service and Devotion to Bowdoin College, Nicholson served as th
class marshal for all class and college functions and was president o
the Bowdoin Club of Rhode Island. He was also a member of the
Alumni Council from 1968-1972.

He began an active career in education as a teacher and coach at
Sanford High School, where he won Maine's Football Coach of the Year
award in 1956. From 1961-1967, Nicholson was director of admissions
at Tilton School in Tilton, N.H. He later served as assistant dean of the
graduate school at the University of New Hampshire, where he
received his master's degree in education. From 1968-1972, he was
director of admissions at Culver Military Academy. He then returned to
Franklin, Mass., where he spent 14 years as the dean of student
affairs at Dean Junior College. After retiring, he was a subsitute
teacher at Mt. Ararat High School.

Dedicated to serving his community, he was a dedicated
Republican, a member of the Masons, an avid participant in the Civil
War Roundtable, and an enthusiastic member of the Boy Scouts, who
awarded him its highest honor of Silver Beaver. He also served for
many years as a New England Track and Field Official. He was also
a veteran of several branches of the armed forces. Mr. Nicholson was a
member of First Parish Church, Brunswick.

Of Scottish heritage, he participated in the Scottish games for
many years. He enjoyed music, fishing, hunting, collecting books and
athletics.

He was predeceased by a sister, Joann Frano; and a brother,
Donald Nicholson.

In 1953, Nicholson married, Elfriede Dagne of Frankfurt, Germany.
He is survived by his wife and five children, Alexander Nicholson
and his wife Joyce of Lakeville, Minn., Petra Nicholson of Boston,
Kirsten Roopenian and her husband Mark of Sudbury, Mass., Jennifer
Vander Yacht and her husband Jeff of Maynard, Mass., and Bruce
Nicholson of Franklin, Mass.; his seven grandchildren; as well as
nieces and nephews.

A celebration of his life will be held Saturday, March 11 at 11 a.m.,
Bowdoin College Chapel in Brunswick. A private burial will be held
Maine Veterans Memorial Cemetery, Augusta.

SCARBOROUGH - Dwight Clifford Nick Nicholson, 79, formerly of Portland, died Dec. 24, 2005 at the Maine Veterans Home.

He was born in North Conway, N.H., the son of Theodore Clifford Nicholson and Ruth Coleman Nicholson. He attended Fryeburg schools, and was a graduate of Fryeburg Academy.


