VASSALBORO – Millard E. Nickerson, 70, a retired state police captain who in 1957 participated in the arrest of "The Great Imposter," Ferdinand Waldo Demara Jr., died Saturday at his home.

He was born in Sanford, a son of Dr. Millard E. Nickerson and Allison Choate Nickerson. He graduated from Sanford High School in 1943.

He served in the Navy Air Service during World War



II, and was a member of the Pacific Patrol Bombing Squadron 22nd Fleet.

After military service he worked at the Charles R. Choate Insulation Co. in Waterville, and later became a self-employed businessman in Brunswick.

Mr. Nickerson joined the Brunswick Police Department and in 1955 joined the State Police. He was chosen that year to

help launch the Criminal Investi-

gation Division, and at the time of his retirement was director of the state police Bureau of Criminal Investigation.

He graduated from the FBI National Academy and from a session of the Federal Bureau of Narcotics Division. He also attended Harvard seminars and federal aviation schools. He organized the security for the Maine State Airport in Augusta.

He served for many years as liaison officer of the governor's task force on major drugs, and helped form NESPAC, a states' organization for mutual self-help.

Former El Cajon city manager Bernard J. Noden, 83, died Thursday (March 14, 1996).

Mr. Noden, a graduate of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, also worked as an engineer, at FAA Construction for 20 years. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge.
