

AUGUSTA-George G. Nickerson, 83, died peacefully with his family by his side on Friday, August 6, 2004 at the Maine Veteran's Home in Augusta.



George G. Nickerson

Born in Fort Fairfield, on October 17, 1920, he was a son of the late Hebert & Florence MacDougal Nickerson.

He was educated in Fort

Fairfield.

In 1940, he joined the United States Army, stationed at Fort McKinley in South Portland, where he later became a recruiting officer. While stationed at Fort McKinley, he and his future brother in law, Allan Trout, were the 30 and 50 caliber machine gun champions of all the army forts in Maine.

He met his future wife, Dorothy Trout while stationed in Maine.

While overseas, he contracted malaria and was hospitalized in California before returning home to Maine. He returned to Scarborough, where he would reside until his passing as well as marry his beautiful bride, of 62 years, until her passing on October 26, 2003.

"Nick" worked for the South Portland Ship Yard till the end of World War II. He also worked for the Boston & Maine Transportation Company as a bus driver & mechanic. He would later join the Scarborough Police Department and attained the rank of captain.

In his semi-retirement, he was assigned officer of Prouts Neck. He will be sadly missed but will always be remembered for his devotion and commitment to his family.

Survivors include, a daughter, Sandra Frost and her husband Robyn of Seabrook, N.H., a son, Stephen Nickerson of Westbrook, two sisters, Stella Gray of Fryeburg and Ann Westmelt of Freeport, two grandchildren, Leah Bouzer and her husband Brian and Robyn Cooley and her husband Doug and six grandchildren.

He is predeceased by his parents, his wife Dorothy, and a sister Lucia Spear.

There will be no Visitation. A grave-side memorial service will be held Tuesday, August 10, 11 a.m., Brooklawn Cemetery, Portland.

arrested 'Great Imposter' in 1957

VASSALBORO - Millard E. Nickerson, 70, a retired state police captain who in 1957 participated in the arrest of "The Great Imposter," Ferdinand Waldo Demara Jr., died Saturday at his home.

He was born in Sanford, a son of Dr. Millard E. Nickerson and Allison Choate Nickerson. He graduated from Sanford High School in 1943.

He served in the Navy Air Service during World War II, and was a member of the Pacific Patrol Bombing Squadron 22nd Fleet.

After military service he worked at the Charles R. Choate Insulation Co. in Waterville, and later became a self-employed businessman in Brunswick.

Mr. Nickerson joined the Brunswick Police Department and in 1955 joined the State Police. He was chosen that year to help launch the Criminal Investi-

gation Division, and at the time of his retirement was director of the state police Bureau of Criminal Investigation.

He graduated from the FBI National Academy and from a session of the Federal Bureau of Narcotics Division. He also attended Harvard seminars and federal aviation schools. He organized the security for the Maine State Airport in Augusta.

He served for many years as liaison officer of the governor's task force on major drugs, and helped form NESPAC, a states' organization for mutual self-help.

On Feb. 14, 1957, Mr. Nickerson was one of two detectives who arrested Demara on the island of North Haven. Demara, who had previously posed successfully as a surgeon, a college professor, a monk and a prison warden, was then acting as North Haven's schoolmaster and superintendent of the Baptist Sunday School.

Following retirement from the State Police in 1973, Mr. Nickerson served as treasurer and manager of the Kennebec County Federal Credit Union.

He was a life member of Post No. 2 American Legion, Augusta, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 887, Augusta. He was also a member of the Vassalboro Masonic Lodge, Elks Lodge No. 96A, the First Baptist Church of Sanford, and various police groups, including the New England FBI Police Association and the Harvard Association of Police Science.

Former El Cajon city manager Bernard J. Noden, 83, died Thursday (March 14, 1996).

Funeral services will be held 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Paris-Fredrick Mortuary in El Cajon under the auspices of the Masonic Lodge. Entombment will be at Glen Abbey Memorial Park.

Mr. Noden was born June 14, 1912 in Malden, Mass. He served as El Cajon's first city manager from 1950 to 1958. Before Noden was hired, each city council member was responsible for a different department, said Hamilton Judy, former mayor of El Cajon and Noden's friend.

"Bernie was honest, straightforward and very intelligent," Judy said. "He was one of the best city managers El Cajon ever had."

Under Noden's management, El Cajon went from 3,000 people to 40,000 people. Recognizing that many post-world War II Navy personnel were seeking to relocate in the East County, Noden was instrumental in annexing land and zoning it for future development. He also helped in getting Broadway widened and paved, and the city's first sewers installed, Judy said.

Mr. Noden, a graduate of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, also worked as an engineer, at FAA Construction for 20 years. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge.

Survivors include his wife, Alice; sons, Richard of Lansing, Mich., and Paul of El Centro; two grandchildren; and one great-grandchild. (swr-de)
