Burluf U. Nissen, 45, of 40 Wood-
 street, vice president of the
 John J. Nissen Baking Company of
 this City and treasurer of the John
 J. Nissen Baking Corporation of
 Bangor, was found dead in his room
 in the Bangor House Wednesday
 night. Identified by John Longstaff,
 manager of the Bangor bakery, after
 a hotel porter found the body, Dr.
 Herbert C. Scribner Bangor medical
 examiner, said death was due to
 coronary thrombosis.

Members of his family said Mr.
 Nissen left Portland Tuesday night
 on his weekly visit to the Bangor

plant, and that he died in his sleep early Wednesday morning.

Born in Denmark, Europe, July 27, 1895, son of Mrs. Anna C. and the late John J. Nissen, he came to Portland as a child with his parents, and was educated in the schools of this City. He served in the U. S. Army during the World War with an artillery unit. Soon after his discharge from the service he entered his father's business, continuing in an executive capacity following the senior's death nearly three years ago.

He was a member of Harold T. Andrews Post, (AL,) the Cumberland Club, Portland Country Club, Portland Lodge, AF&AM, St. Alban Commandery and other branches of Masonry and Kora Temple, Order of the Mystic Shrine.

Surviving besides his mother are his widow, Mrs. Hilka M. Nissen; twin children, John and Shirley; a sister, Mrs. Helen Beaton of Toronto, Ont., and a brother, Lieut. Walter U. Nissen, vice president of the baking company, now serving at Camp Edwards.

In this Country his training as a baker and cook took him at once to the far West, where he went to work as cook for a construction gang which was helping to push the lines of the Northern Pacific Railway on to the Pacific Coast.

Byron W. Nichols, 74, of 80 Pleasant Street, widely known in New England as a scenic artist, died in a Portland hospital Monday after a long illness.

He was born at Florence, Mass., Sept. 22, 1873, the son of Byron W. and Annis Avery Nichols. He was educated in New Haven, Conn., and later studied at the Boston Art School and the Cowles Art School.

After serving his apprenticeship in Boston, Mr. Nichols came to Portland in 1905 with Byron Douglass, the actor, and painted scenery at the Portland Theater and later for the E. V. Phelan Stock Company at the Cape Theater.

A Shriner, Mr. Nichols painted scenery for several Masonic organizations in Southern Maine before his retirement about 10 year ago.

His wife, Mrs. Annie Ross Nichols died here in 1934. Surviving, besides a sister, Mrs. M. C. Walz of New Haven, Conn., are a son and daughter, whose whereabouts are unknown.
