Anthony P. 'Tony' Notis Anthony P. 'Tony' Notis was born on Aug. 13, 1934 in the rugged mountains of Northwestern Greece in the town of Politsani. After World War

II, he was forced to escape his homeland due to communist occupation. It took him and his family three days to make it to freedom, living in caves during the escape. He immigrated to the United States in February of 1946. He passed through Ellis Island when he was 11 years old, and saw his father, who had already immigrated to America, for the first time in seven years. Mr. Notis graduated from South Portland High School and was a star athlete in football and track. After graduating, he entered the restaurant business. He owned and operated the Bridgeway Restaurant for over 47 years. He expanded the restaurant several times though the years, and believed the key to success was hard work and an optimistic attitude. He enjoyed being self-employed. The business is now run by his son Alex. Mr. Notis was proud to be an American citizen and truly cherished the freedoms of this country having seen some of the atrocities of World War I as a child. He became a member of the U.S. Navy Reserves in the 1950's and was trained as a medic. He received an honorable discharge from the Navy reserves. In 1961, Mr. Notis traveled to Athens, Greece to meet Vasso Rammos. They married shortly thereafter, in Greece, and returned to

Maine. Mr. Notis was active in the church and the community. He was past president of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church, and a founding member of AHEPA, and past president of the local Politsani Society. The Politsani Society is a worldwide organization of individuals from the same hometown, Politsani. In 1987, Mr. Notis organized a reunion of families that immigrated from Politsani. The reunion was held at Fort Preble along Willard Beach, and 300 people attended traveling from all over North America. He was of the Masons, Hiram Lodge Number 180 A & FM in South Portland, 32 Degree Scottish Rites, Portland Commandry, and the Kora Temple Shrine. In addition he was a past member of the Elks Club in Portland, Kiwanis Club, and a charter member of the Eagles Club in South Portland. He had also served as a

DeMolay advisor. He was a current member of the South Portland Lions Club. He was a very active member and was the fund raising chair for the Lions Club Camp Sunshine fund raisers. Due to his efforts, Gov. King proclaimed April 1996 Camp Sunshine month. As for personal activities, Mr. Notis enjoyed skiing in his youth and boating throughout his life. He always liked being on the ocean. He was an avid gardener and enjoyed spending hours in his yard tending to his flowers and fruit trees. He also enjoyed traveling. Mr. Notis is survived by

his wife of 42 years, Vasso Notis; two sons, Philip A. and Alex C. Notis, both of South Portland; a daughter, Nancy Notis and her husband, Ron Currier, of Rye Beach, N.H. and his beloved grandson, Ari P. Notis, of South Portland. He is also survived by his mother-in-law, Sophia Rammos; nieces, nephews and other relatives from Greece, along with a sister; and two nieces from Massachusetts. Visiting hours will be from 6-8 p.m. Thursday at the Hobbs Funeral Home, 230 Cottage Road, South Portland. A funeral service will be held 11 a.m., Friday at the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church. Interment will be at the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery in the spring. Stonington, Oct. 16—Dr. Benjamin Lake Noyes, 75, one of the first physicians to use the X-ray, in practice here for 50 years, a trained electrical therapist, skilled surgeon and registered pharmacist, died this morning of pneumonia in the Eastern Maine General Hospital, Bangor.

Dr. Noyes was born at Lisbon Falls, May 30, 1870, the son of Dr. George B. and Sarah Lake Noyes. He received his education in the Grand Manan, N. B., schools and at Bowdoin College.

Widely-known in this part of Maine as physician and surgeon, his hobby was genealogical research and his Penobscot Bay region archives contain the histories of many early Maine families.

He became interested in X-rays during his last year at Bowdoin Medical School. At that time Prof. Franklin C. Robinson, who had been following with interest the revelations of the wonders of the Roentgen rays, began experiments along these lines, and Dr. Noyes assisted him in this work. Subsequently he kept in touch with all the new steps taken in X-ray experimentation, and he used this method of treatment in many cases, especially cancer. He also had the distinction of owning and operating the first "radio knife" in this part of the Country.

Dr. Noyes was greatly interested in political affairs and in 1936 he sought the candidacy for United States Senator on an independent ticket in opposition to Senator Wallace H. White, Jr., Republican, and Louis J. Brann, Democrat. In the announcement of his candidacy he said he was fully in accord with the principles of the National Union of Social Justice, promulgated by the Rev. Charles E. Coughlin of Royal Oak, Mich., and "sincerely in harmony with the Townsend Plan."

He was denied a place on the ballot on the ground that there were not one thousand valid signatures among the 1,667 on his papers, after he had appealed to the Supreme Court following Secretary of State Lewis O. Barrows' ruling that the number of signatures was not sufficient.

He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Reliance Lodge of this town, of King Arthur Lodge, Knights of Pythias, the Grange, the Lions Club, the Hancock County, Maine and American Medical Associations; the New England Historical and Genealogical Society and the Maine Historical Society.

Dr. Noyes was twice married, his first wife being Linnie Howard of Deer Isle. By this marriage there were three children, the late George Howard Noyes, Mrs. Natalie Cleveland and Mrs. Janice Greenlaw.

Surviving are his widow, Estelle; two daughters; a sister, Mrs. Florence Lamson of Malden, Mass.; three brothers, D. Jewett, George and Galen, all of Stonington; four grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

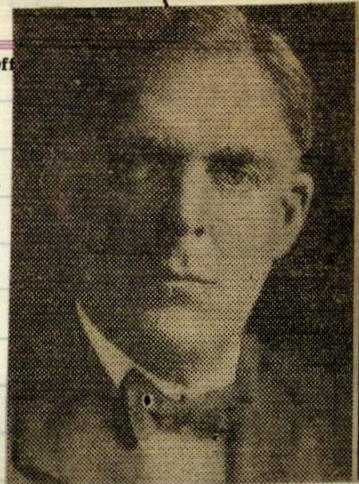

Herman F. Noyes, for 37 years an employe of the Maine Central Railroad and for nine years up to his retirement in February superintendent of the motive power department, died this morning in Portland.

Mr. Noyes was born in Freeport, Aug. 1, 1876, the son of Amos and Almira Davis Noyes. He entered the service of the Maine Central on March 4, 1902 as a locomotive fireman. Four years later he was promoted to assistant air-brake inspector, then held successively positions of air-brake inspector, traveling engineer, motive power inspector, superintendent of fuel economy, assistant superintendent of motive power and finally was superintendent of this latter department.

At the time of Mr. Noyes' retirement in February, officials and employes of the railroad presented him with a token of appreciation of his many years of devoted interest to his work and to those with whom he worked.
