

Calvin Henry Norris Of Bar Harbor A Victim Of Heart Disease

BAR HARBOR, Nov. 24. (Special)—Calvin Henry Norris, 69, widely known as a contractor and builder, superintending the construction of the Building of Arts and other well known buildings in this and other places, died suddenly at his home on Glen Mary road late yesterday afternoon, his body being found lying against the door at the entrance of his home by his wife upon her return. Death was due to acute heart disease, Dr. C. C. Morrison, who was summoned, stating that he had been

dead about two hours.

Mr. Norris was born here Nov. 4. 1856. He had been engaged in the contracting business for many years. and besides the Bar Harbor Building of Arts had supervised the construction of many of the fine summer homes at this noted resort, among them the homes of Edgar Scott, J. 
