Henry W. Oakes

Retired Superior Court Justice Henry W. Oakes of Auburn, father of Attorney Raymond A. Oakes of this city, died at his home Tuesday af-

ter a lingering illness.

Judge Oakes was born at Auburn, April 26, 1957, the son of Dr. Sylvester and Hannah Kilbourne Oakes. He attended Auburn grammar schools and was graduated from Bates College, where he was a star baseball pitcher, in 1877. He read law with Frye, Cotton and White at Lewiston and was admitted to the bar in 1880, He was in practice with A. R. Savage until he joined the firm to be known as Oakes, Pulsifer and Ludden.

In 1917 he was appointed by Governor Carl Milliken to the bench of Androscoggin Superior Court, where

he served until reaching the retirement age of 70.

At Bates College he was an overseer from 1884 until 1918 and was secretary of the board of trustees. He became a member of the Board of Fellows in 1918 and was awarded the degree of Doctor of Laws in 1928.

He was twice elected to the Legislature and became a vice president of the Lewiston Trust Company in 1928. He was a member of the Kiwanis Club and a 32nd degree Mason. He had been a member of the Auburn Board of Education and the old type city council.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs.

Thalie Toothaker Oakes, a niece Mrs. Methyl Oakes Palfrey of Boston, and four grandchildren, Henry W. Oakes, 2nd, Robert Oakes, Granville Oakes and Miss Dorothy Oakes. Funcral services will be held at his home at Auburn at 2 p. m., Thursday.
