KENNEBUNK — Stanley E. Page, 81, of Gendron Lane died Friday at Kennebunk Nursing and Rehabilitation Center after a brief illness.

He was born in Bucksport, a son of Harry C. and Ella Erskine Page, and graduated from Bucksport High School in 1936. He graduated from Pratt Institute School of Engineering, Brooklyn, N.Y., in 1941, where he had been president of the Chess Club.

He was employed by Westinghouse Co., Cambridge, Mass. for 15 years, then by Simplex Wire and Cable Co., also of Cambridge, for over 22 years. During this time he lived in Braintree, Mass., where he was a member of the town meeting, president of the junior and senior high school parent teacher associations, chairman of the finance committee and a member of the First Congregational Church of Braintree, where he taught Sunday school and served as deacon.

He moved to Kennebunk with his wife and youngest daughter in 1970, upon being transferred by Simplex Wire and Cable Co. to its North Berwick office. He remained there for two years, and was then employed as an engineer by Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, Kittery, for several years. He also worked for several years as clerk of the works for Maine Medical Center, Portland, and for Bowdoin College, Brunswick.

He was a 50-plus year member of the Masonic Lodge, Bucksport.

He was also a member of the Christ Church, Kennebunk, and served on the finance committee.

He served as president of the Alamoosook Protective Association, Orland.

He enjoyed woodworking and playing bridge. He also enjoyed racing his Catfish catamaran and won several times.

Surviving are his wife of 56 years, Sara Blodgett Page of Kennebunk; one son, Nathaniel B. Page of Mercer Island, Seattle, Wash.; two daughters, Priscilla Lopez of Placentia, Calif., and Hannah F. Marston of Kennebunk; one brother, Robert H. Page of Marysville, Pa., and five grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at Christ Church, Dane Street, with the Rev. Lynn Bujnak officiating. Burial will be in Oak Grove Cemetery, Orland. Arrangements are by Bibber Memorial Chapel, Kennebunk.

DOVER-FOXCROFT - Wood-row Evans Page, 93, died Aug. 9, 2006, at a local nursing home. He was born Feb. 23, 1913, in Burlington, the son of the late Rufus and Nina (Beane) Page. He was a graduate of East Corinth Academy, Class of 1931, the University of Maine, Class of 1935, with a Bachelor of Science in civil engineering, the University of Michigan, Class of 1938 with a master's degree in public health engineering and the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College in 1959. He was a registered professional engineer. He was a surveyor with the U.S. Corps of Engineers, Passamaquoddy Tidal Project 1935-36; sanitary engineer with the Maine Department of Health and Welfare 1936-50; solely made a sanitary survey map of the City of Bangor, pop. 30,000, including roads, houses, water and sewer lines and information of each dwelling; administered the Federal Hill-Burton Hospital Construction Program for Maine 1950-73, which included construction of most of the general hospitals of the state and additions, some mental and retardation facilities and one hospital for autistic children, a total of 93 projects. He served as ordnance maintenance officer, 51st Group Headquarters, 1st U.S. Army, European Theater; gave the order to send tank transporters to Omaha Beach to secure German tetrahedrons and to return them to our Ordnance Maintenance Cos. to make attachments for the front of tanks that would knife through hedgerows that allowed the 1st Army to break through to the St. Lo, France area. He was awarded the Bronze Star for this action. He also was awarded Five Battle Ribbons and retired as a lieutenant colonel in the U.S. Army Reserves. He served on the boards of directors of Maine Blue Cross/Blue Shield from 1962 to 1999, the Maine Lung Association, Maine Legal Services for the Elderly, Maine State Employees Association and was a trustee of Foxcroft Academy from 1962 to 1999. He was a life member of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity, a member of the Charleston Masonic Lodge, AF & AM, Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor, IOOF of Corinth, Reserve Officers Association, Life, former member of the Military Order of World Wars, the Retired Officers Association, Life, Maine Hospital Association, American Association for Hospital Administration, Life.

SCARBOROUGH — Earl C. Paine, 88, a devoted family man, expert plumber and longtime union member, died Saturday after a long illness.

Mr. Paine, of Asselyn Drive, died at Maine Medical Center in Portland after battling bone cancer. His wife of 57 years, Marge Paine, was with him, holding his hand when he died.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He was the most wonderful man," his wife said. "I loved him deeply."

The Paines met when she was 18-year-old Marge Merserve. She had just moved from Richmond to Portland to "explore the world," she said.

"I was working at the Cafe Congress Buffet Lunch across from Portland City Hall, slinging hash for \$7 a week plus tips and a meal a day. Earl started coming in. He was nice looking ...

and had nice eyes. He was making \$25 a week, which was big money then."

The Paines waited three years to marry. She said she knew she had married a kind man, but didn't realize how kind until her mother fell ill with cancer and came to live with the Paines for five months until her death on March 1, 1945.



Earl Paine weekend when overtime rates were in effect, his wife said.

"Earl was so good about it. He cared so much about my mother and you can imagine how much that meant to me," she said.

Mr. Paine worked as a plumber for 37 years, retiring in 1974 after working for E.N. Cunningham and Scribner & Iverson. He had a soft spot for people who were struggling financially, especially if they had to call a plumber during the

"He would go into their homes and fix up their problem just enough to tide them over until Monday, when they could get someone in for a more reasonable rate," his wife said. "He was that kind of man."

Mr. Paine worked in residential plumbing, but his forte was the "big jobs," his wife said, such as work at Westbrook Junior College, the Windham Correctional Center and South Portland High School.

Mr. Paine belonged to the Steam Fitters Union local for 58 years. After his retirement, he and his wife divided their time between their home in Scarborough and a winter home in St. Petersburg, Fla., where he loved to set up a chair on the causeway and fish.

"He was happy if he caught one and happy if he didn't," his wife said.

Mr. Paine was born in Buxton, a son of Joseph L. and Sophronia Smith Paine. He graduated from Buxton High School in 1923.

He also was a member of Hiram Masonic Lodge and the Scottish Rite of Portland and the Washington Avenue United Methodist Church in Portland. He also enjoyed watching baseball, especially the Red Sox.

Mr. Paine also is survived by two sons, Larry M. of Lowell, Mass., and Rodney of Cape Elizabeth, and a daughter, Emily R. Paine of Cape Elizabeth.
