## Dr. Chas. F. Parker, South Windham, Dies

Dr. Charles F. Parker, 67, for 35 years a practicing physician at South Windham, died early this morning at his residence on Mallison Street, South Windham, after a brief illness.

#### CREIGHTON L. PARKER

WINTERPORT - Creighton "Grampy" Parker, 75, died Feb. 28, 1996, at a Bangor hospital after a courageous battle with cancer. He was born in Arlington Mass., Nov. 14, 1920, the son of Archibald S. and Edna (Earle) Parker. Creighton attended schools in Arlington and during high school he worked at Gammel's Garage; graduating from Arlington High School, Class of 1940. In 1942, he married the former Ruth E. Staples. Creighton worked at Bethlehem Steel Company in Quincy, Mass. for seven years, prior to moving to Winterport in 1947, where he made his home in the community that he loved dearly. Creighton was employed by the Arthur Chapin Company in Bangor until he began working in the Winterport School System in October of 1962. He transferred to Hampden Academy in 1981, where he worked until his retirement in 1989. Following his retirement, he worked part time for S.A.D. No. 22 until 1995. Creighton served his community in many capacities, Winterport Fireman, Winterport Town Constable, Waldo County Deputy Sheriff and Waldo County Civil Defense Director for the Town of Winterport, Winterport Cemetery Committee, was a member, longtime treasurer and an honorary treasurer of Howard Masonic Lodge No. 69 A.F. & A.M. and was a former member of the Winterport Lions Club. Creighton was one of the founders of the established Winterport Ambulance and Rescue Service and in 1974 became chief of the Winterport Fire Department. He served in that capacity for 22 years. This was considered his most prized accomplishment, having served his fire department and his community for 50 years. In 1978, he was pleased to fly to Indiana to purchase Winterport's newest fire truck. Creighton helped the department grow to its present size and was very proud of the firemen that he trained and served with. "The Fire
