Walter Partridge, 75, veteran retired grocer, died Sunday morning in his home, 171 Ashmont Street, after an illness of several months.

Mr. Partridge, a resident of this city about 63 years, had been in the grocery business here more than 50 years, many years at Woodfords Corner and for 20 years on Casco Street. He sold his business and retired about six years ago. Late in the last century, Mr. Partridge was active in light harness racing circles in the State, driving three or four of his own horses at the fairs.
