HENRY PAUL

**BANGOR** — Henry Paul, 92, a well-known Bangor clothier, died Jan. 30, 1995, at his home after a long battle with cancer. He was born in Somerville, Mass., in 1903. His family came to Bangor in search of new business opportunities, settling in this city in the early 1900s. Mr. Paul began his retail career in Bangor in 1918, working long hours after school at Bangor High so that he could earn enough money to go to college. He attended both the University of Maine and Columbia University. After completing one semester at Columbia, he was called home because his father, John Paul, was in ill health. At the age of 20, he assumed responsibility as head of his family, taking care of his widowed mother, brother and three young sisters. Over the years, he built the small 10 foot family business into a large, highly respected firm, the John Paul Co. The business was known throughout the region for its "Short or tall, big or small, John Paul fits 'em all" slogan, which Henry Paul wrote and then aggressively promoted through one of the area's earliest television advertising campaigns. Henry Paul took an active role in the upbringing and education of his three younger sisters, Freda, Mildred and Alice. He brought his younger brother, Sidney into the John Paul Co., where they worked together as partners and friends until Sidney's death in 1970.

Henry Paul took on the same role of teacher, mentor and friend with his son, John Richard Paul, who became his business partner in 1964. They continued to work side-by-side for 20 years, until their retirement in 1984. Family was central to Henry Paul's life. His son, two daughters, four grandsons and three granddaughters always looked to him as a role model, guided by his commitment to lifelong learning, nurtured by his constant love and support, and charmed by his lively wit and keen sense of humor. Henry Paul's leisure hours were shaped by his belief in physical fitness and his love of learning. He was an avid golfer, walked two miles a day in all weather, adhered religiously to a daily home exercise routine, swam whenever possible, and aggressively advocated a low-fat diet to anyone who would listen -- long before it became the national rage. His daily routine included reading the New York Times and the Wall Street Journal. He was fluent in Spanish, building on what he had learned through his travels in Mexico and Spain, attending night classes, listening to tapes and reading textbooks. Despite his rapidly failing health, he was insistent on exercising his right to vote in person as recently as our November election, only a short time before his death. Mr. Paul was a member of St. Andrews Lodge No. 83 AF & AM of Bangor. 10 years ago he received a 50-year veterans medal from the Grand Lodge of Maine. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Bangor and Anah Temple Shrine. The Bangor Rotary Club honored him in 1991 by making him a Paul Harris Fellow. He was a founding member of a Pinewood/Lucerne Country Club and a member of the Penobscot Valley Country Club. He was also a member of the Beth Israel Synagogue and B'nai B'rith. Mr. Paul survived by his wife of 60 years Gertrude (Berger) Paul. She worked steadfastly by his side in the John Paul Co., shared his love and commitment to their family, and was his favorite golfing partner. As his illness progressed, she took him for long daily rides around Bangor, listening to the classical tapes they both loved. In addition to his wife

Gertrude of Bangor, survivors include his three children, John Richard Paul of New York City, Jane (Paul) Fishkin of Omaha, Neb., and Elizabeth (Paul) Levenson of Portland; his seven grandchildren, Dr. Paul A.S. Fishkin of Peoria, Ill., Charles Fishkin of New York City, James Fishkin of Washington, D.C., Joel Fishkin of Bloomington, Ind., Suzanne (Levenson) Berzins of Portland, Rebecca Levenson of Charlottesville, Va., and Meredith Levenson of Washington, D.C.; his pride and joy, seven months old great-grandson, Henry Paul Fishkin of New York City, named in his honor; and his sister, Alice Hinden of Sharon, Mass. Funeral services will be held 12 noon Thursday at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, Bangor, with Rabbi Joseph Schonberger officiating. Interment will be at the Beth Israel Cemetery.
