Ocala, Fla. — Charles D. Peckham Jr., 82, formerly of Whitinsville, Mass., and Ocean Park, Maine, died Wednesday at his home here.

Born in Hopkinton, R.I., he was a son of Charles D. and Ida Mae Harris Peckham. He was a 1917 graduate of Westerly High School, attended the University of Rhode Island and graduated from General Electric Apprentice School in Lynn, Mass., in 1923.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War I.

Mr. Peckham resided in Ocean Park for more than 34 years before he moved to Whitinsville, Mass., to live with his son. He moved here in 1978.

## Karl Pedersen

'His life . . . was the sea'

Capt. Karl Pedersen, 95, of Bismark Street died Thursday at a Portland hospital.

"His life, actually, was the sea," said a son, Karl Pedersen. He spent the greater part of his life on ships ranging from Danish square-riggers to steamships to yachts owned by Hollywood stars.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He also owned and operated the Cushing Island ferry Paul until his retirement in 1972. "The people down there loved him because he was so accommodating," his son said.

- he didn't want to give it up," David Pedersen said.

He joined the Danish merchant marine and came to the United States in the early 1920s. After seeing America during a trip, he simply walked off his ship in Boston and made his way to Portland. He later became a citizen and sailed with the U.S. Merchant Marine and the Coast Guard.

He was a quartermaster on various steamships, and served as master of various yachts of Hollywood figures such as Howard Hughes and Lionel Barrymore.

He made four to six trips a day, seven days a week between the island and the mainland, said another son, David Pedersen of Cushing Island. Both sons said his picture with the ferry is in many homes on Cushing Island today. "Everybody remembers him well," David Pedersen said.

Even after he retired, his life revolved around the sea. "He was well in his 80s when my mother finally made him stop lobstering

"His big thing used to be that if (his wife) wasn't around, he'd sneak down and go out in the boat," Karl Pedersen added. "He enjoyed life and he enjoyed people."

"He always had a twinkle in his eye," David Pedersen said, adding that his wife referred to that trait as "Santa Claus eyes."

Capt. Pedersen was extremely knowledgeable because of his travels. "You couldn't play Scrabble with him or geography games because he knew every seaport and every big ocean port in the world," David Pedersen recalled.

He was born in Aarhus, Denmark, a son of Niels and Karoline K. Gregersen Pedersen, and attended schools in Denmark.

During World War II he was employed at the South Portland shipyards and was promoted to head lead man of the West Yard, welding Liberty ships.

He was a self-employed lobsterman, caretaker of Cushing Island, as well as caretaker of the historic Fort Levett on the island, and caretaker for the federal government at Fort McKinley on Great Diamond Island before it was redeveloped as a housing complex.

Capt. Pedersen was a member of the Danish Brotherhood in America, the Mayflower Lodge and the Atlantic Lodge of Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 63 years, Marie Horn Pedersen of Portland; two sons, Karl of Forest Lake at Gray and David of Cushing Island; eight grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild.

Visiting hours will be from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. today at the Conroy-Tully South Portland Chapel, 1024 Broadway. A funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at the chapel. Burial will be in Forest City Cemetery, South Portland.

His works, which included about 45 historical novels, had been published in England, Germany, and Czechoslovakia as well as this country and had been circulated throughout the English speaking world.

Born in Pittsfield in 1875, son of George Jefferson and Mrs. Clara B. Watson Pendexter, he attended the public schools and Nichols Latin School in Lewiston and entered Bates College.

He left Bates at the end of his first year to accept a job teaching in Norway and there met Miss Helen M. Faunce who he married in 1897. A year of teaching at Phillips followed, but in 1900 he

paper, from his fellow novelists, and from a reading public at one time one of the trade's widest.

Among his most famous books were "Old Misery," "Kings Of The Missouri," "The Dark Road," "The Wife Ship Woman," "A Virginia Scout," "The Bush Lopers" and "Gentlemen Of The North." Besides historical novels, he was the author of eight boys' books and a humorous volume.

He was a member of the Authors' League of America and of the London Society of Authors, Playwrights and Composers. He was an honorary life member of the Kansas Historical Society, and belonged to the Masonic Lodge and the Kiwanis Club at Norway.

Bates College awarded an honorary Master of Arts degree to him in 1933.

Mr. Pendexter had written as many as five novels in a year, and when he retired from newswriting in 1911 took a five-year contract for two 90,000-word volumes a year and two additional serial novels a year, a total output of between 300,000 and 400,000 words a year.

His later novels were published at somewhat slower pace and after extensive investigation, but when he wrote he wrote an average of 6,000 words a day and for many years published at least one volume a year. More of his books were published in England than in the United States. His biography has been in "Who's Who in America" for many years.

Besides his widow, Mr. Pendexter survived by two sons, Hugh, Jr., of Philadelphia, and Faunce of Portland; a grandson, Hugh, 3rd, of Philadelphia; and several nieces and nephews.
