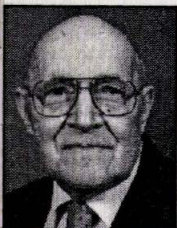

Arthur Percious guide, symphony violinist

SOUTH PORTLAND — Arthur Theodore Percious, 32, of 97 Coach Road, a violinist and retired Canadian Pacific Railroad engineer, died Thursday at a Portland hospital.

He was born in Worcester, Mass., a son of Joseph A.T. and Victoria M. Jarvis Percious, and attended Worcester schools.

He began studying the violin as a child and at age 19 he played violin for silent movies at the old Strand Theater in Portland. He also taught the fiddle at a music school located in the former Portland YMCA building at Free and High Streets, where the Portland Museum of Art is now located.

Mr. Percious then moved to the Portland area and took up the violin again and within a year or so he was playing for the Portland Symphony Orchestra. He was also a member of the Community Orchestra of the Portland Symphony, taught violin lessons and made and repaired violins.

Last December Mr. Percious had provided violin accompaniment for a performance of "The Nutcracker" by the American Ballet Co.

He was a member of the Bingham Masons.

Alfred Perkins, 89; insurance man ^{2/8/00} and state legislator

BROOKSVILLE — Alfred W. Perkins, a former legislator and past executive vice president of Union Mutual Life Insurance Co. in Portland, died Feb. 5, 2000, at his home. He was 89.

Born in Portland, Ore., a son of Edward W. and Chrissie M. Gott Perkins, he graduated from the University of

Maine in 1930.

He pitched for his home team in Brooksville and at the University of Maine. He had been approached about pitching professionally, but decided to teach at the university, his family said.

Maine was in the middle of the Depression and although he loved teaching, Mr. Perkins soon realized that working as an actuary would provide a better living. He spent most of his career as executive vice president of Union Mutual Life Insurance

Co., which changed its name to Unum when it became a stock company.

Mr. Perkins enjoyed helping others — but “never really spoke up and said a lot,” said his son, Robert Perkins. “He was always in the background, supportive.” Mr. Perkins served as a state insurance commissioner under Govs. Horace Hildreth and Sumner Sewall, and helped established the Maine State Retirement System, his family said.

A staunch Republican who loved Maine and the Brooksville area, Mr. Perkins went on to complete two terms as a state representative during the administration of Gov. James Longley. “He just thought he could do something for the area. He did it because he wanted to serve . . . all the work he was doing was to serve others,” said his son. “He was always proud of the fact that he could get some bill passed that benefited the Deer Isle-Brooksville area.”

Mr. Perkins served as a lieutenant in the Navy during the Pacific campaign of World War II.

For 17 years he owned Seal Bay Camp for girls and often took riders and horses to horse shows throughout the state, his family remembered. Mr. Perkins was also an avid golfer. Whenever he traveled for business, he made sure to check out the local courses. “I don’t think there’s a golf course in America he didn’t play on,” said his son.

He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge.

Surviving are his wife of 68 years, Monty; one son, Robert E.; one daughter, Dr. Ann P. Ellis; three grandchildren, Ann R. Perkins, Margaret P. Osborn and Christine A. McLaughlin; and two great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. today at Blue Hill Congregational Church with the Rev. Robert McCall officiating. Spring burial will be in Mount Rest Cemetery. Arrangements are by Healey Funeral Home, Blue Hill.

He also had been self-employed as a cabinetmaker and finish carpenter.
