**OGUNQUIT** — Carl W. Perkins, 88, of Scotch Hill, a teacher and innkeeper, husband of Florence M. Brown, died Friday at a York hospital following a lengthy illness.

Born here, a son of William H. and Lizzie Parsons Perkins, he was a graduate of Wells High School in 1914, and the University of Maine in 1919.

He was an Army veteran of World War I.

Mr. Perkins taught chemistry in Orange, Mass., and Fitchburg, Mass., where for 31 years he was head of the science department, retiring in 1956.

He taught chemistry at Portsmouth (N.H.) High School from 1958 to 1961.

He had been an innkeeper at Scotch Hill Inn since 1919, was a

member of the Board of Education in Wells, and a trustee of St. Peter's by the Sea Church, Cape Neddick.

He was also a member of the Masons, OES, American Chemical Society, American Legion, New England Teaching Association, National Retired Teachers Association and St. George Episcopal Church at York Harbor.

OGUNQUIT — Cecil F. Perkins, 79, of Hillcrest Manor Nursing Home, Sanford, formerly of Ogunquit, died Monday at his residence after a brief illness.

He was born in Ogunquit, Oct. 25, 1902, son of Ernest and Annie Johnson Perkins, and graduated from Wells High School, Wells. He attended Mt. Herman's Boys School, Northfield, Mass., and Gray's Business School, Portland.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Jennie Powers Perkins; a son, Frederick; a daughter, Mrs. Marion P. Dudley; two sisters, Miss Lila B. Perkins and Mrs. May Roberts, the latter of Brooksville, and three brothers, Frederick of Brooksville, Morris of Vassalboro and Harvey.

Mr. Perkins, who was the Maine head of the Ku Klux Klan about 10 years ago, was born at Brooksville, the sixth in a family of 10 children. He attended the Eastern Maine Conference Seminary in Bucksport after completing his grade school education, but left that school before graduation to start his teaching career at the age of 18 in Arrostook County. After four years as a teacher he attended the University of Maine.

With the advent of the Spanish American War, he volunteered but got only as far as Augusta. He returned to the college and was graduated in 1900, with the degree of Bachelor of Philosophy and Master of Arts. A post graduate course in the University of Chicago followed and he secured his degree of Bachelor of Law there before continuing

his law studies at Indiana University.

Returning to Maine he taught in Hancock, Penobscot, Arrostook, Somerset, Waldo and Cumberland Counties. He was principal of Freedom Academy before going to Skowhegan and Madison. He served for six years as principal of Skowhegan High School and was district superintendent of Skowhegan and Madison, when he was called to Portland as superintendent of schools in 1911.

After seven years he resigned to become executive secretary of the Portland Chamber of Commerce. After serving in that capacity for three years he became manager of the Congress Square Hotel, and afterward was in the real estate business.

During the K. K. K. activity in Maine he was very active, and was Grand Dragon of that organization for three years up to June, 1928. Still later he was proprietor of a garage on Brighton Avenue.

Mr. Perkins had held about every important office a Maine educator could hold, and was at one time talked of as a successor to Dr. Augustus O. Thomas, state commissioner of education. He was president of the Maine Teachers' Association in 1911, president of the Maine Association of School Superintendents in 1910, president of the New England Association of School Superintendents in 1912, State Director of the National Educational Association for four years, president of the Maine Schoolmasters Club in 1909, and president of the Portland Rotary Club in 1916-1917.

During the World War he was county director for War Savings, chairman of the Portland Food Conute Speaker. He was a member of the Phi Kappa Sigma Fraternity, and at servation Committee, and a Four Min-one time a member of the Woodfords Club.



DeForest H. Perkins, 63, of West Paris, formerly widely-known as an educator, for seven years superintendent of Portland schools, later secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, then manager of the Congress Square Hotel and subsequently engaged in business here, died Friday in the State Street Hospital, where he underwent an operation last Monday.

Mr. Perkins had been a resident of West Paris for the last six years and was proprietor of two general stores in the town of Paris, one at North Paris and the other at Trap Corner.

BOOTHBAY HARBOR - James Glenn Perkins Jr., 82, a local attorney, died Wednesday in a local hospital.

Born here, a son of James B. and Fannie Orne Perkins, he graduated from the local high school in 1929 as valedictorian and class president. He also graduated from Hebron Academy in 1930, Bowdoin College in 1934 and Harvard Law School in 1937.

In 1936, he was admitted to the Maine bar, was elected Lincoln County attorney in 1938 and became a member of the Workers' Compensation Commission in 1963, serving for 17 years, the last 17 months as acting chairman.

After serving six months in the Army during World War II, he applied for a Navy commission and was assigned to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, where he was responsible for ordering investigations of Navy officers from 1943 to 1945. He also served under the commander of U.S. Naval Forces in Europe and in the office of the naval attache in London. After that duty, he participated in a revision of the Article for Government of the Navy under Secretary of the Navy James Forrestal.

On returning to civilian life in 1947, he made an unsuccessful bid for the Republican nomination for Congress in what was then the 2nd District. Mr. Perkins also was one of six Maine delegates to the 1952 Republican National Convention in Chicago that nominated Dwight D. Eisenhower for president.

While a private in the infantry, he married Patricia Anne Irwin in Macon, Ga.

Mr. Perkins was town meeting moderator here for 35 years and moderator of Community School District meetings for 25 years. He helped organize the Boothbay Region YMCA and was instrumental in acquiring Fort Island and the former Walter Buzzell property on Back Narrows Road in Boothbay. The property was subsequently sold with the proceeds going to support the purchase of land and the YMCA building in Boothbay Harbor.

He was a member of the American Legion, Boothbay Harbor Rotary Club, the Congregational Church (honorary deacon), Knights of Pythias, the local A.F. & A.M. lodge, St. Andrews Free Bed Fund, Royal Arch Masons, Boothbay Harbor Memorial Library (past president and trustee), Cemetery District, the PTA, the Mayflower Society, the state and Lincoln County bar associations, and the American Trial Lawyers' Association. He was also a Fellow of the American College of Probate Council.

The community named an athletic field behind the high school for Mr. Perkins.

Surviving are his wife of 53 years, Patricia Anne Perkins; three daughters, Judith Perkins Wright of Portland, Ore., Sarah Frances Perkins of Tacoma, Wash., and Sandra Lynn Perkins of Seattle; two sons, Rear Adm. James B. III of Panama and Thomas I. of Portland; and six grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Congregational Church. Arrangements are by Simmons C. Harrington Funeral Home.
