

Former Legislator Is Dead At Alfred

ALFRED, Jan. 25. (Special)—Lucius M. Perkins, 87, retired lumber dealer and former town official and member of the Legislature, died Wednesday night at his home here. He was born in Brooksville and in his early life he resided in Dover-Foxcroft, and there served for a time as superintendent of schools. He came here 50 years ago as manager of the B. C. Jordan Lumber Co., and following the death of Mr. Jordan in 1912 engaged in the lumber business for himself, in which he was very successful.

Sept. 29, 1879, he married Miss Mary Lufkin of Castine, who survives him, as also two daughters, Miss Mary Hallowell Perkins, of the faculty of the University of Oregon, and Miss Elizabeth S. Perkins of this town; and two grandchildren, the Misses Marjorie and Phyllis Whitehead, daughters of Agent Howard R. Whitehead of the Pepperell Manufacturing Co., in Biddeford.

Mr. Perkins was a member of Fraternal Lodge of Masons of Alfred and Protection Lodge, A. O. U. W., of Dover-Foxcroft.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock from the home, the Rev. Charles L. Stevens of the Congregational Church officiating.

Walter H. Perkins, 89, formerly of Hallowell and Falmouth, died Monday at a nursing home in Portland.
