HE WAS BORN in Auburn Sept. 3, 1887, the son of the late Fred and Lovisa Perkins. He attended Auburn schools and was a graduate of Kent's Hill Academy.

Mr. Perkins, 83, was a native of Kennebunk, born Aug. 16, 1858, the son of Stephen and Mary Jane Perkins. He was educated in the public schools of Kennebunk, Bowdoin College and Washington University Law School, St. Louis, Mo.

He was a former York county attorney, member of the Maine House of Representatives in 1899 and delegate to the Republican national convention in Chicago in 1916.

In addition to his law office here, he had for many years maintained an office in Portland.

He was a member of Greenleaf Lodge, F. & A. M., Corona Chapter, OES, Ossipee Valley Lodge, IOOF, Ossipee Lodge, K. of P., and Theta Delta Chi Fraternity of Bowdoin.

Mr. Perkins was married April 22, 1896, to Miss Effie B. Littlefield of Eliot, who died Jan. 9, 1941.

LINCOLNVILLE and WASHINGTON,

PA. — Cmdr. Frank Chase Perry, U.S.N., Lincolnville's most decorated serviceman in World War II, died May 18, 1993, at the Washington Hospital. Born May 24, 1917, at Syracuse, N.Y., he was the son of Charles Adams and Henrietta Chase Perry. After his mother's death and while he was still a small child, he and his father moved to his paternal grandparents' home in Lincolnville. From the Beach School here, he went on to Camden High School, where he graduated with the Class of 1933. After one year at the University of Maine, Orono, Perry successfully sought appointment to the U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis, Md. Graduation from the Academy in 1939 took him quickly into World War II. A junior officer on the U.S.S. Hornet at the Battle of Midway, he was next assigned to Pensacola NAS for flight training. As a naval aviator, he was thereafter engaged in the Pacific Theatre, notably in the

Battle of the Phillipines. By the time that, as a commander, he took retirement after 21 years as a naval officer. Perry had twice been awarded the Navy Cross, as well as receiving the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal. Returning to Lincolnville for several months, Perry was raised in King David's Lodge, AF & AM and became a charter member of the local VFW post. At Purdue University in 1962, he earned a master's degree in mathematics, fitting him for his second career, teaching that subject at Washington and Jefferson College for 15 years. His Rotary membership, commenced in the Camden club, was extended in the Washington club. There he served on the East Washington Borough Council; was a vestryman and former warden of the Trinity Episcopal Church; and enjoyed the Reserve Retired Officers Group. Surviv-

ing, in addition to his wife of 47 years, Jeanne B. Perry; are his stepmother, Estelle Hale Perry of Portland; one son, John H. Perry of Scenery Hills, Pa.; two daughters, Mrs. Charles F. (Lila) Sleeper of St. Augustine, Fla. and Jane Perry of Pittsburgh, Pa.; and one grandchild, Leah C. Sleeper.
