The Rev. Arthur G. Pettengill, 77, pastor of Preble Chapel here the past 31 years, died suddenly of coronary occlusion Sunday evening as he was delivering a Thanksgiving sermon in the pulpit of his church.

Efforts to revive him were futile. The attack was his second in five months. He recovered from a similar illness last June.






