# Capt. F. A. Peterson, Prominent Mason, Dies At Rockport

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Special Despatch to The Press Herald

Rockland, Oct. 16.—Capt. Frank A. Peterson, 82, died today at his home in Rockport after a long illness.

He was one of the best known Masons in the State, being a 32nd degree Mason and a charter member of the Past Officers' Club made up of those who had served as presiding officers of all the Masonic bodies. For many years he followed the sea and after his retirement was a resident of Rockland and engaged in business here. He has always been a Republican and in 1897 was an alderman. At the time of his death he was a member of the Rockport Town Committee.

He is survived by his widow, and three sons, Albert S. Peterson, and Samuel R. Peterson of Rockland and Ambrose A. Peterson of Vinalhaven; and a daughter, Mrs. Jennie E. Kaler of Rockland.

The funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock from the Bowes and Crozier parlors, Rockland, the Rev. F. F. Fowle officiating.

**WARREN** - Maj. Harry Reeves Peterson, 56, a teacher, job training specialist and decorated Vietnam War veteran, died unexpectedly Monday at Penobscot Bay Medical Center, Rockland.

In 1953 he was valedictorian of the two-student graduating class of South Bristol High School. Maj. Peterson's military career began in 1957, immediately after his graduation from the University of Maine.

He rose to the rank of Army major and served two tours of duty in the Vietnam War. He received numerous decorations, including a Bronze Star with a Combat V. During one tour, at the beginning of the war's escalation, he served as an adviser to the city of Dalat.

It was in South Vietnam that his high school class gained notoriety for holding an impromptu reunion.

Maj. Peterson was described by friends and family as a happy-go-lucky outdoorsman who had numerous interests, including gardening, music, birdwatching, hunting, fishing and cooking. He tended a sizable vegetable garden each year, according to his brother, and he canned and pickled much of the produce.

"He delighted in having a cellar full," said his brother. "If everything fell apart, he'd have enough food to get through."

"He always made homemade vinegars and nifty things from his garden," said his sister-in-law, Maggie Peterson. "He was a neat guy that way."

Maj. Peterson was also a talented pianist, according to his brother, who added that he was very knowledgeable in classical music.

Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of Murray G. and Susan Reeves Peterson. He was a member of the Anchor Lodge of Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 19 years, Dorothy L. Peterson of Warren; three sons, Stephen of Warren, Shaun of New Hampshire, and Alan of New Mexico; two brothers, William of South Bristol and John of Italy.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Monday at Hall Funeral Home, Waldoboro. The Rev. Samuel Henderson will officiate. Burial will follow in the Maine Veterans' Memorial Cemetery, Augusta.

## Carroll Edward Philbrick

### longtime aviator, FAA official

CAPE ELIZABETH — Carroll Edward Philbrick, 77, of Algonquin Road, a retired Federal Aviation Administration official, died Saturday at a local nursing home.

#### PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He was born in Biddeford, the son of Charles and Bertha Kimball Philbrick. He attended Saco elementary schools and graduated from Thornton Academy, where he played center on the football team.

Mr. Philbrick became interested in flying at a young age, and was a self-taught pilot by age 20. He flew with the Biddeford Flying Club in the late 1930s.

During World War II, Mr. Philbrick served as a bombardier and aerial photographer stationed

at Edwards Air Force Base in Riverside, Calif.

From 1945 to 1950 he was owner of the Kennebunk Airport.

In the early 1950s, Mr. Philbrick was a flight instructor at Columbus (Miss.) Air Force Base and Moore (Texas) Air Force Base, training pilots for action in the Korean War.

retired from the FAA in 1983.

"He loved flying," said his daughter, Gloria Moline of South Portland. "He had other interests, like gardening and golfing, but he spent a great deal of time with planes and airports."

Mr. Philbrick received numerous awards from the FAA for flight safety.

He also earned recognition for service. Family members say he once flew a sick baby and a nurse out of the iron fields of Idaho to a hospital in Boise, Idaho. The Boise airport had no lights on the airstrip when he arrived, but he flew in guided by the town's neon lights and his memory of the field.

Mr. Philbrick was a member of the York Masons in Kennebunk, the Quiet Birdmen Association, Portland, and the Falmouth Rod and Gun Club.

In 1957 he joined the FAA, and held instructor and inspector positions at airports in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Albany, N.Y., and at the FAA regional office in Burlington, Mass.

He served in the Portland office of the FAA from the late 1960s to the late 1970s, and for several years was supervisor.

Mr. Philbrick directed formation of Northeast Airlines out of Burlington, VT, until his retirement from the FAA in 1983.
