It was in South Vietnam that his high school class gained notoriety for holding an impromptu reunion. Maj. Peterson was described by friends and family as a happy-go-lucky outdoorsman who had numerous interests, including gardening, music, birdwatching, hunting, fishing and cooking. He tended a sizable vegetable garden each year, according to his brother, and he canned and pickled much of the produce.

"He delighted in having a cellar full," said his brother. "If everything fell apart, he'd have enough food to get through."

"He always made homemade vinegars and nifty things from his garden," said his sister-in-law, Maggie Peterson. "He was a neat guy that way."

Maj. Peterson was also a talented planist, according to his brother, who added that he was very knowledgeable in classical music.

Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of Murray G. and

Susan Reevs Peterson. He was a member of the Anchor Lodge of Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 19 years, Dorothy L. Peterson of Warren; three sons, Stephen of Warren, Shaun of New Hampshire, and Alan of New Mexico; two brothers, William of South Bristol and John of Italy.

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways. He was born in Biddeford, the son of Charles and Bertha Kimball Philbrick. He attended Saco elementary schools and graduated from Thornton Academy, where he played center on the football team.

Mr. Philbrick became interested in flying at a young age, and was a self-taught pilot by age 20. He flew with the Biddeford Flying Club in the late 1930s.

During World War II, Mr. Philbrick served as a bombardier and aerial photographer stationed

at Edwards Air Force Base in Riverside, Calif.

From 1945 to 1950 he was owner of the Kennebunk Airport.

In the early 1950s, Mr. Philbrick was a flight instructor at Columbus (Miss.) Air Force Base and Moore (Texas) Air Force Base, training pilots for action in the Korean War. In 1957 he joined the FAA, and



held instructor and inspector positions at airports in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Albany, N.Y., and at the FAA regional office in Burlington, Mass. He served in the Portland office

of the FAA from the late 1960s to the late 1970s, and for several years was supervisor.

Mr. Philbrick directed formation of Northeast Airlines out of

Burlington, VL, until his retire-

"He loved flying," said his daughter, Gloria Moline of South Portland. "He had other interests, like gardening and golfing, but he spent a great deal of time with planes and airports."

Mr. Philbrick received numerous awards from the FAA for flight safety.

He also earned recognition for service. Family members say he once flew a sick baby and a nurse out of the iron fields of Idaho to a hospital in Boise, Idaho. The Boise airport had no lights on the airstrip when he arrived, but he flew in guided by the town's neon lights and his memory of the field.
