YORK FRANK PHILBRICK
keeper and a veteran of the Boxer Rebellion, of Route 91 died Tuesday at a Portsmouth, N.H., nursing home after a long illness. 3-14-1989

He was born in Somerville, Mass., a son of Herbert and Alice Donnell Philbrick.

Mr. Philbrick served in the Navy during the Boxer Rebellion, an uprising in China in 1900. He was also a commander in the Coast Guard Auxiliary and patrolled the York Harbor area during World War II.

From 1911 to 1913 he ran the lighthouse at Halfway Rock, a bare rock off Portland Harbor that once held a kerosene lamp enveloped in lenses.

He was a member of the First Parish Congregational Church and was a 66-year member of the St. Aspinquid Masonic Lodge.

His first wife, Elizabeth Fisher Philbrick, died previously.

His second wife, Ruth Nowell Philbrick, died in 1981.

Three sons, George, Francis and Herbert Philbrick, all died previously.

Two daughters, Ethel Freeman and Louise Trafton, both died in 1988.

Surviving are a son, Russell Avery Philbrick of Malibu, Calif.; a daughter, Alice Sylvia Gove of Whittier, Calif.; a sister, Gladys Philbrick of Kittery; 19 grandchildren, 29 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Friday at the Lucas and Eaton Funeral Home, 91 Long Sands Road. Burial will be in First Parish Cemetery.
