Thomas R. Phinney

Thomas R. Phinney, 86, engaged in the ice and milk business more than half a century, died suddenly from a heart attack Thursday afternoon in the milk shed of his farm on the Gorham Road, South Portland.

Born at South Portland, son of Major C. and Rebekah Roberts Phinney, Mr. Phinney was a descendant of Capt. John Phinney, who came to Portland in 1732 and moved to Gorham four years later, a daughter, Mary Gorham Phinney, being the first white child born in that town.

He married Sarah Abbie Davis of Sebago Lake and after residing there a year and then a year in Portland he moved to South Portland, where he since lived, 32 years on Westbrook Street and the rest of the time on the Gorham Road, owning and supervising a 165-acre farm.

Mr. Phinney was a member of Hiram Lodge of Masons more than 50 years, Maine Lodge, IOOF, 65 years, and Ivanhoe Lodge, K. of P., 45 years. He attended the 13 Class sessions many years and was a regular attendant at church services, for some years following the practice of visiting a different church each Sunday.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Clifford Greenlaw of South Portland; two sons, Clinton C., who made his home with his father, and Clarence L., superintendent of the Cape Elizabeth Town Farm; six grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Mrs. Phinney died seven years ago.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. DST Sunday in his home, and interment will be in Brown's Hill Cemetery.

Funeral services for William F. Phinney, 76, retired general agent of the American Agricultural Chemical Company, who died Sunday evening at a local hospital, will be held Wednesday in Wilde Memorial Chapel. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mr. Phinney, born at Sebago, Jan. 20, 1861, son of the late William and Harriett Spear Phinney, received his education at Boston and Somerville, Mass., where he lived 11 years before moving to Standish, and later to Deering Center.

He had been general agent for the American Agricultural Chemical Company 50 years before his retirement five years ago because of failing health. At one time he also served as treasurer of the Twin Village Water Company of Damariscotta, and for several years was a member of the old Deering city government.

He was a member of Local Valley Lodge, of West Buxton; a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Deering Lodge No. 143, Mt. Vernon Chapter No. 1, Portland Council, Portland Commandery, Kora Temple, and Trinity Episcopal Church. He was a past president of the Maine Charitable Mechanics Association.

Surviving him are his widow, Mrs. Clara Pennell Phinney, a daughter, Mrs. Jane Phinney Harlow of this City, widely known dramatic reader; and a grandson, William Pennell Harlow.

LIVERMORE FALLS - Bernal L. Phillips Sr., 83, a resident of Bass Point Road in Livermore, died Thursday, March 25 at the Parkview Nursing Home where he had been a patient since February of this year.

Herbert Owen Phillips, 76, president of the Eastern Grain Company of Portland until his retirement about 10 years ago and widely-known in Maine for his connections with the grain business, died Christmas morning in his home at Forest Park, after a year of failing health.

He was born here Feb. 1, 1869. In 1872 the family moved to Biddeford, where Phillips received his early education. Returning to Portland in 1883, he began his career the next year as a news agent on the Maine Central Railroad. Still a young man, he entered the employ of the Norton-Chapman Company, Portland, a grain, flour and feed company, as office boy. He became general manager of the firm in 1898, continuing in the capacity until 1902 when he purchased the Eastern Grain Company. As head of that firm, he founded a chain of grain stores throughout Maine with headquarters here.

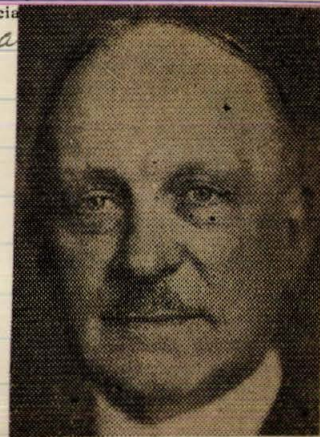
