



He was an enthusiastic member of the First Congregational Church of Wiscasset, U.C.C., and had served on most of its committees.

He was predeceased by a sister, Lilla Buck.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years; two daughters, Nancy L. McDonough of Somersworth, N.H., and Darryl A. Beliveau of Manchester, N.H.; four grandchildren and seven great grandchildren





home and spending time with his family.




