He was predeceased by a sister, Lilla Buck.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years; two daughters, Nancy L. McDonough of Somersworth, N.H., and Darryl A. Beliveau of Manchester, N.H.; four grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
