Gorham, Jan. 7—The body of George C. Pike, 80, past master of Cumberland County Pomona and Saccarappa Granges, was found at noon today on the kitchen floor of his home on School Street by a neighbor who did his housework. Apparently he was stricken with heart disease as he prepared breakfast, according to Dr. William Holt of Portland, medical examiner. He lived alone.

Mr. Pike was born at Harrison, son of Noah and Sophia Wilson Pike, moved to Westbrook in 1885, and came to Gorham seven years ago. He was married in 1889 to Mary Cobb of Westbrook, who died in 1926. He had been a farmer and a stone mason and retired several years ago.

He attended the Warren Congregational Church, Cumberland Mills, and belonged to Crooked River Lodge, F. and A.M., Bolster's Mills.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Geneva Haskell of Westbrook, Miss Leah E. Pike of New Bedford, Mass., and Mrs. William H. Stewart of Brownville Junction, and a sister, Mrs. Annie P. Stokes of Harrison.

Bar Harbor, July 2—Funeral services for Charles B. Pineo, 84, widely known Bar Harbor attorney, who died late Friday night after a long period of failing health, will be held at 3.30 p. m. Sunday in St. Saviour's Episcopal Church.

He was born Nov. 7, 1854, at Harrington, son of the late Charles Byron and Mary Marrow Pineo, and came to Bar Harbor in 1877. He married the former Flora Rodick in 1884. Mrs. Pineo died in 1926.
