AUGUSTA — Funeral services for Albert M. Pingree, 85, of 8 Linden St., retired state accountant and widely known in Masonic circles, will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at 15 Flagg St.

Mr. Pingree died Thursday night in the Augusta General Hospital.

Mr. Pingree entered state employment in the controller's office in 1936 and was assigned to the liquor accounting section. He retired in the middle 1940s.

Previously he had been with the U.S. Internal Revenue Service from 1922 to 1934; the Fuller-Holway Company, 1915 to 1922 and the Augusta State Hospital, 1902 to 1915.

In Masonic circles, he was a member of both the York and Scottish Rites, and an honorary member of the Supreme Council, 33rd Degree.

Born May 12, 1880, in Ripley, Mr. Pingree was the son of Daniel P. and Calista Spencer Pingree. He was graduated from St. Albans High School in 1899. He married Elsie Mae Grant of St. Albans, who survives him, on Sept. 16, 1903.

Mr. Pingree was made a 33rd degree Mason in 1940, following years of activity in the craft, which he continued until his death. He had been recorder of Trinity Commandery since 1921 and secretary of the Augusta bodies of the Scottish Rite since 1933.

He was a past master and past secretary of Augusta Lodge; last high priest of Cushnoc Chapter; past thrice illustrious master of Alfa Council; past commander of Trinity Commandery; a past worthy patron of Rose of Sharon Chapter, OES, and a 32nd degree Mason since 1912.

He was prominent in the Republican Party, served on the Penobscot County committee two terms, chairman of the Newport town committee three terms and was a deputy sheriff of this county six years. His appointment as superintendent of buildings at Augusta was one of the first made by former Gov. L. O. Barrows. In the Summer of 1940 he was granted a leave of absence on account of his health and last Winter returned to his home in Newport where he was in failing health until his death.

He was a past master of Meridian Splendor Lodge, AF&AM, a member of Stevens chapter, Royal Arch Masons, all of Newport; Mt. Moriah Council, R&SM of Skowhegan and Sebesticook Grange, Newport. For many years he served as clerk of Riverside Cemetery Association, Inc., and since returning to Newport was appointed to that position. Dr. Harold A. Pingree, 71, prominent Portland orthopedic surgeon, died suddenly in the lobby of a local hotel Wednesday afternoon.

The cause of his death was given as a heart ailment by his physician. Doctor Pingree, who had been in poor health for some time, had complained about one-half hour before his collapse of feeling ill.

Doctor Pingree had distinguished himself as an orthopedic surgeon for 45 years, practicing most of his life in Portland. He acted as chief orthopedic surgeon at the Maine General Hospital from 1933 until 1943, and as chief of the medical staff of the Chil-

dren's Hospital from 1933 to 1947.

Less than an hour before his death, Doctor Pingree had spoken before the Board of Managers of the Children's Hospital in opposition to their plan to merge that institution with the Maine General.

Doctor Pingree was born Jan. 16, 1877, in Portland, son of Dr. Malcolm C. Pingree and Cora Dodge Pingree. He attended schools in Portland and Cape Elizabeth, and was graduated from Portland High School in 1894.

He was a graduate of Maine Medical School at Bowdoin College in the class of 1901. After graduation he interned in the Maine General Hospital. He began the practice of orthopedic surgery with Dr. Edville G. Abbott in 1903.

Doctor Pingree joined in founding the Children's Hospital in 1908. He was an instructor in orthopedic surgery at the Maine Medical School from 1905 to 1922.

He was a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a member of the American Medical Association, the Maine Medical Association, the Cumberland County Medical Society and the Portland Medical Club.

Doctor Pingree was also a member of Portland Lodge, AF and AM.

A bachelor, Doctor Pingree is survived only by a half-sister, Mrs. Sewall W. Percy of Spruce Street, Portland; and two nieces, Miss Ann Percy of Portland, and Mrs. Arthur S. Hawkes of Cape Elizabeth.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 1.30 o'clock at 749 Congress Street. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

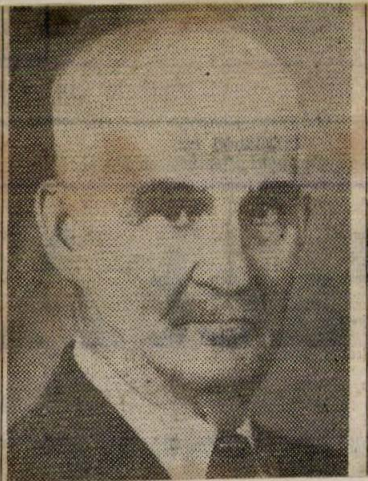
