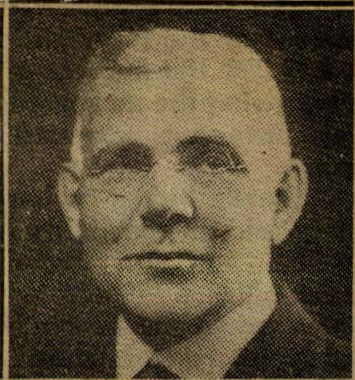

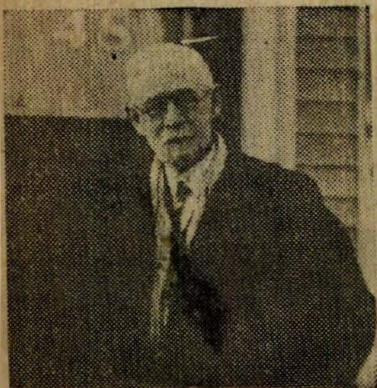

Albert S. Plummer, Lewiston and Auburn's oldest undertaker, member of the firm of Plummer & Merrill, which he established, passed away Sunday night, Oct. 9, at his home, 48 Wood Street, Lewiston, at the age of 85. He had been in failing health since February when he suffered a shock.

Mr. Plummer was born in Portland, Aug. 8, 1847, the son of William H. and Mary Weymouth Wilkinson Plummer. His father was deputy marshal under Neal Dow. He lived in Portland until he was 21 years old, beginning his apprenticeship in the furniture business with the Walter Corey Company when he was 17 years old. Four years later he moved to Lewiston and has resided there ever since.

Mr. Plummer entered the undertaking business in 1891, his first partner being Algernon Roak. This partnership continued for 13 years until the death of Mr. Roak. The business then was conducted in the usual store manner of the undertaking business in those days.

On the death of Mr. Roak, Charles E. Merrill entered into the partnership with Mr. Plummer and remained until his death seven years later. The firm name continued as Plummer & Merrill, but the business is now conducted as a corporation.
