ADDISON - Richard S. Pollard died unexpectedly Aug. 22, 2006, while at work. Dick was born June 30, 1934, in Milo, and spent his younger years on his family's potato farm in Mesardis.

He graduated from Kents Hill School and enlisted in the Navy for four years. Dick spent 13 months at McMurdo Sound, South Pole, as a radio operator. In his later years, he developed a slide show of his experiences there and presented the show at many public gatherings. Dick completed his education under the GI Bill at the University of Maine - Orono, where he majored in agricultural engineering.

Dick and his wife, Gladys, moved to Addison in 1983. He managed a blueberry farm for RH Foster for a number of years, and later worked at Pleasant Bay Bed and Breakfast and Llama Farm until he passed away. Dick will be remembered with fondness by his many friends in Addison and elsewhere. His was always a hand ready to help. We will miss him.
